No. 1 Constitutional Amendment. Article IX, Section 4 and Article XII Partisan Election of Members of **District School Boards**

No. 4 Constitutional Amendment, **Article I, New Section Amendment to Limit Government**

Interference with Abortion

No law shall prohibit, penalize, delay, or restrict abortion before viability or when necessary to protect the patient's health, as determined by the patient's healthcare provider. This amendment does not change the Legislature's constitutional authority to require notification to a parent or guardian before a minor has an abortion.

No. 5 Constitutional Amendment, Article VII, Section 6 and Article XII Annual Adjustments to the Value of **Certain Homestead Exemptions**

Proposing an annual adjustment for inflation to the value of current or future homestead exemptions for which every person who has legal or equitable title to real estate and maintains thereon the permanent residence of the owner, or another person legally or naturally dependent upon the owner is eligible.
