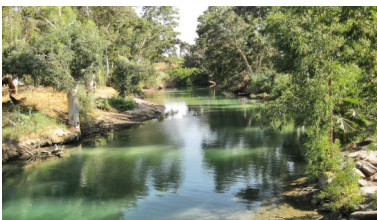

Come walk with us in the footsteps of Jesus, stand on the Mt. of Beatitudes, sail the Sea of Galilee on a 1st century replica fishing boat, walk through the Old City of Jerusalem to the site of Jesus' crucifixion, and celebrate His resurrection at the empty tomb. Bible sites come alive as we visit Mt. of Olives, Mt. Zion, and Bethlehem. We will focus on the ministry of Jesus as we visit the area of Galilee. We will also visit Amman; Ancient Philadelphia, Jerash, Ajloun, Bethany Beyond the Jordan, Madaba, Mt. Nebo, and Petra. This tour includes airfare, hotels with breakfast and dinners, comfortable A/C coach, transfers, entrance fees, scholarly guides, and many extras at one price that individual travel does not match. Join us on this exciting and spiritual pilgrimage to Israel and Jordan.

Places of Interest.....

Israel and Jordan, March 4-16, 2019

M-Day 1 Depart U.S. for flight to Israel.

T-Day 2 Arrive Tel Aviv Ben Gurion Airport. Meet our guide and transfer to hotel. Overnight in Jerusalem.



W-Day 3 Mt. of Olives; Church of the Ascension, then begin the "Palm Sunday" walk, stopping at Pater Noster Church, commemorating Jesus' teaching His disciples the Lord's Prayer and Dominus

Flevit, ending in the Garden of Gethsemane, the place of Jesus' agony, betrayal and arrest, and Church of All Nations, which

contains the rock where Jesus is believed to have prayed before His betrayal and arrest. Continue to Mt. Zion; St. Peter's in Gallicantu, which is built over the site of the house of the



High Priest Caiaphas and the stone pit where Jesus was held. Three times, Peter also denied knowing Jesus near this same place. At the end of the day, visit the Garden Tomb. Overnight in Jerusalem.

TH-Day 4 Start the day by visiting the Temple Mount, Western Wall, and the Holy Sepulchre.



After lunch, continue to the Israeli Museum to see the Model of Jerusalem and Shrine of the Book, which contains the Dead Sea Scrolls. Overnight in Jerusalem.

F-Day 5 Bethlehem area; Herodian; Herod's palace, and Solomon's Pools; during Roman times a system of springs filled three mammoth rectangular reservoirs supplying water through aqueducts to Jerusalem and the Herodian. Church of the Nativity and Shepherd's Field. Enjoy a lunch at the Grotto. Overnight in Jerusalem.



S-Day 6 Sea of Galilee, including: the Mount of Beatitudes; Tabgha, the place of Jesus' miracle of the Multiplication of the Fish and Loaves, Primacy of Peter, and Capernaum; known as "Jesus' home town." We will also take a boat ride on the Sea of Galilee, and enjoy a St. Peter's Fish lunch. Stop by Yardenit; Jordan River baptismal site at the end of the day. Overnight in Galilee.

S-Day 7 Check out of the hotel. Visit Mt. Tabor, the site of Jesus' transfiguration and a view of the Jezreel Valley. Drive to Jericho for lunch and a view of the Mt. of Temptation. Continue to the Dead Sea for floating. Overnight in Jericho.



M-Day 8 Check out of the hotel. Transfer to Jordan via Allenby Bridge by 8:00 AM. Amman City tour; (Under Ptolemy II Philadelphos (285-247 B.C.), Amman was rebuilt and renamed Philadelphia. In 63 B.C., Philadelphia became part of the Decapolis set up by Pompey. It is likely that David's men concentrated their campaign against the city at this point, and perhaps it was here that Uriah was killed at David's order in 2 Sam 11:16-17). Dinner and overnight in Amman.



T-Day 9 Visit the ancient city of Jerash; formed part of the Roman province of Syria following General Pompey's conquest of the region in 64 BC. It later became one of the ten cities of the Decapolis league, flourishing and growing wealthier over two centuries of Roman rule. Also visit Ajloun - Qa'lat ar-Rabad; The name 'Ajloun goes back to a Christian monk who lived on this mountain in the Byzantine period. The castle stands on the ruins of a monastery, traces of which were discovered during archaeological excavations. Dinner and overnight in Amman.

W-Day 10 Check out of the hotel. Visit Bethany beyond the Jordan; traditional site of Jesus' baptism, Mt. Nebo: where Moses saw the Promised Land, Madaba: one of the towns divided among the 12 tribes of Israel at the time of the Exodus, visit St. George's Church and Mosaic Map depicting all the major biblical sites of the Middle East. Overnight in Petra.

TH-Day 11 Full day at Petra: Tour with the guide to see the Siq, Treasury, Theatre, and Street of Facades. There will be ample free time for you to visit the Royal Tombs, High Place of Sacrifice, and the Monastery, if you should choose. Overnight in Petra.

F-Day 12 Depart Jordan via Allenby Bridge. Transfer into Israel. Drive to Jaffa for a walk through the Old City and to see the port. You will then have a farewell dinner. Transfer to hotel for overnight.

S-Day 13 Transfer to airport for flight back to U.S. Arrive in ORD.
