### **Scholarship Information**

The amount of the scholarship award is \$250.00. It will be sent to the selected college or university of the recipient upon verified enrollment of full time status.

Important dates to remember:

June 30, 2015 Completed packet must be postmarked by this date.

**July 15, 2015** Notification to all applicants will be e-mailed advising of award or denial of award.

**August 15, 2015** Payment (on or after this date) will be made to recipient's college or university. In order to receive payment the recipient must show proof that he/she is registered for classes. A payment in the amount of \$250.00 will be mailed to the school.

#### **Scholarship Eligibility**

- 1. Applicant must be a graduate (or will graduate in 2015) of an accredited high school and will be attending college in the fall of 2015.
- 2. Applicant must have a cumulative high school GPA of at least 2.7 on a 4.0 scale, or are currently in college and have a grade point average of 2.7 on a 4.0 scale.
- 3. Applicant must be affiliated with a fire protection district that is a member of the Southeastern Washington Fire Commissioners Association. Affiliation includes all active members of any Fire District or their immediate family (spouse or children).
