A federal judge has sentenced a U.S. Army veteran to a 25 year prison term for espionage in a Tampa courtroom. Kelley Warren was sentenced to the maximum term allowed under her plea agreement. While stationed in then West Germany in the early 1980's, Warren acted as a conduit passing along secret military information headed by U.S. Army Sgt. Clyde Conrad. He was later convicted in Germany of treason and died in prison while serving a life sentence. As US. District Judge Elizabeth Kovachevic~ NJ pronounced the maximum sentence, Warren's relatives ran from the courtroom crying.
