The Shore Based Water Rescue course is designed to train emergency response personnel in the most current techniques of shore based water rescue. The basic intent of this course is to teach the following key elements that everyone should know and understand before they approach the water to affect a rescue:

- PREPLANNING
- INCIDENT COMMAND
- SELF RESCUE
- SHORE BASED RESCUE TECHNIQUES

The student will learn these skills both in a classroom setting and in practical exercises. This course lays a strong water safety foundation for all emergency personnel in your organization. This class will help establish a common ground of water rescue training before advancing to the more technical aspects of water rescue.

All equipment necessary for the class will be provided. Students are welcome to bring equipment to class; however, the lead instructor will inspect the equipment before use. Questions about equipment may be emailed to the instructor before class or discussed during breaks within the course.

As a courtesy to everyone, please see that all radios, pagers and cell phones are either turned off or switched to the silent mode during class. These items prove to be very distracting to other students. If a student is required to take a call, please do so outside of the classroom. There is absolutely no smoking permitted in the classroom, during practical exercises, or near any rescue equipment at anytime.

Pets and children are not permitted at the classroom session or the practical exercises. Water rescue training is intense and absolutely all of your attention must be focused on the class and safety issues.

Each person in this course will have AT LEAST two very important responsibilities:

1. If you do not understand something, it is your responsibility to ask questions. We may have a tight schedule, but we will always take the necessary time to answer your questions or address your concerns.
2. You are directly responsible for your own safety and the safety of each person in this class.
