We are glad you are here today! You could be anywhere, doing many different things, and yet you are *here* worshiping Jesus with us!

If you are unfamiliar with our service, let me take a moment to share a few key things:

- We believe God loves our worship from the youngest to the oldest of souls. There is a nursery space with a loving attendant available for the littlest ones, 2 years and younger, and activity bags at the back of the sanctuary are provided for the older children.
- We come to the Lord's table each Sunday for Communion believing that this is a privilege extended to all who call upon the name of Jesus Christ as their Lord and Savior.
- We don't have a time for offering. It has been a longstanding belief that God provides the necessary funds for this church family. As a visitor, we would never expect you to give. However, if the Lord calls you to do so, there are slots on the desk in the foyer and a box on the middle post of the sanctuary doors.

At the halfway point in the Gospel of Mark, Jesus makes a dramatic shift in His mission and purpose. Up until this point, Jesus has compassion on the people around Him and meets their needs through His strength. But the nearer Jesus approaches the cross, He meets

everyone's real need of redemption through His weakness. What would happen if we continued following Jesus to the cross? How would our lives be different? How would this world be impacted? Let us see together as we continue through Mark's account of Jesus' life!

WALKING IN GOD'S WORD

We acknowledge that the Bible is God's truth and provides direction for our lives. Seeking biblical truth is vital, both in our church and in our personal devotions.

DAY 1: Mark 12:1-12

- What does the vineyard represent? Who is the owner? The son? Who are the tenants? The servants? What was Jesus prophesying by telling this story?
- How do you make Jesus feel welcome in your life each day? What actions of yours might make Him feel unwelcome?

DAY 2: Mark 12:13-17

- What was dangerous about this trap? Why do the Herodians (allied to Rome) and the Pharisees make strange partners?
 What if Jesus had just said yes? What He had just said no?
- If it's the coin that you give to "Caesar," what do you give to God? What often prevents you from giving to God what is God's?

DAY 3: Mark 12:18-27

- What characterizes "resurrection life"? How does Exodus 3:6 (quoted in v.26) demonstrate the fact of the resurrection?
- Which do you know more about the Scriptures or the power of God? What are your hopes for growing in the other area?

DAY 4: Mark 12:35-44

- As you are thinking through both stories, when is "more" actually "less"? When is a "little" a "lot"?
- When are you tempted to think you have more than you actually do? When are you tempted to think you have less than you actually do?

DAY 5: Mark 14

Skim through the chapter. What stands out to you?
