## Journal Entries

Each week you will be required to write a short journal entry about the verse for that week. Below are some ideas of what to write about. You can choose write about any or all of these ideas:

- Explain what you think the verse means in your own words.
- Why is the verse important?
- How does the verse make you feel?
- How does this verse apply to you and your life?
- What other examples can you think of from the Bible that go along with this verse?
- Write about the verse in your own way.
- Share how God is working in your life right now. What else is he teaching you? What do you want to improve on as a Christian?
- Nov. 10: What is sin? What does it mean when it says that we were "dead in our sins"? What can you do this week to help you avoid sinning?
- Nov. 17: What does it mean to be made "alive in Christ"?
- Nov. 22: What is grace? How did God show you grace? How can you thank him this week?
- Dec. 1: How were we raised up from the dead like Jesus?
- **Dec. 8**: What are the rewards (riches) of God's grace? How can you share the message of these rewards with others?
- Dec. 15: What does it mean to have faith? How can you strengthen your faith?
- Jan. 5: How do people get to go to heaven? Can we "earn" our way to heaven by doing good deeds? Why do you think God designed it that way?
- Jan. 12: What are "good works"? Why should we do them? What were some "good works" you did this past week? How did it make you feel to do them? What are some good things you can do for someone else next week?
