Welcome to Buckeye Equestrian Events Dressage Schooling Show:

We hope you enjoy this inaugural event being held at the premier equestrian exposition center, Eden Park. The show is meant to have a relaxed, and enjoyable atmosphere where you can enjoy showing your horses in an array of classes in a schooling –type show environment. Please take the time to review the show information and guidelines listed here and on the next page:

All entries must be made online or postmarked by April 29th, 2017

- ♦ Full Payment is required when submitting entries. Check or Money Orders should be made payable to: <u>Buckeye Equestrian Events A</u> fee of \$50 will be assessed for all returned checks!
- ♦ USEF/USDF Rules will be observed. ASTM approved helmets are required when riding at all times. Dress for event is semi-casual. Arena will be standard size (20 x 60 m).
- Eden Park Rules: All bedding must be purchased on site (or pre-ordered)-no outside bedding is permitted. All horses on the grounds must have a stall. Showing out of the trailer is not permitted. Each horse must wear a bridle number at all times when showing.
- Judges scores are final, show management reserves the right to combine, split, or cancel classes as needed.
 No refunds are administered after ride times have been posted.
- Ride times will be posted at www.buckeyeequestrianevents.com, you may also choose to enter online and pay via PayPal.
- All dogs must be leashed while on show grounds. Arrival is permitted after Friday, May 5th at noon. A food stand is available on both show days located in the cafeteria area.
- Show Office will be open Friday 12-7:00 pm and then an hour before show time and an hour after the last ride on each show day.
- Youth age is 21 & Under as of Jan. 1st.
- Premiums will be paid out to each test type division and then separated as well into status divisions (youth/amateur/professional). Awards will be given for individual classes as well 1st –5th (i.e. ribbons, prizes, etc.)

Class Descriptions

Sport Horse in Hand: The purpose of this prospect in hand class is to evaluate the potential, suitability and qualities as a dressage sport horse (or performance horse).

Equitation: Open to youth and amateur competitors. Purpose of class is to evaluate the dressage rider's correct position, seat and use of aids.

Prix Caprilli: a dressage test with jumps in it. This class offered at this show will be for horses working at the Training level or above. The official test being used will be posted on the show website.

Dressage Trail: The purpose of this fun class is to demonstrate obedience, handiness and response to rider's aids. The horse must softly accept the bit and may show more "roundness" in the parts of the test separate from the obstacles. Posting is optional. Transitions into and out of the halt may be done through the walk. Test may be called. Collectives: Safety (Handling obstacles); Submission (Attention to aids, confidence, cooperation); Rider (Seat and position, correctness and effectiveness of aids) X2;140 points possible. Class will be towards the end of the day. The official test will be posted on the show website.

Pas de Deux Freestyle: Music is mandatory, must indicate at what level you will show at for horses at Training level and above. Guidelines and permissible maneuvers can be found on USDF website or pattern posted on show website. Take note of maximum time limits. Music must be turned in to show secretary upon check in. Music burned onto a CD (disk) is preferred.
