COVID-19 ADDENDUM FOR 2021 MARKET OPERATIONS

The FFM will be operating again at the Grocery Outlet in Ferndale, WA.

The Board has agreed to get back to normal as possible while being mindful of all requirements on COVID-19.

In doing our part in slow the spread of COVID-19 cases in Washington State the FFM will work closely with the Whatcom County Health Department to take necessary steps to protect public health. In this ever-changing situation with COVID-19. Any changes will be communicated as soon possible.

We, as Vendors and Board members, play an important role in keeping each other as well as our shoppers as safe as possible from COVID-19 by following recommended guidelines.

Booths will be spaced with adequate distant apart from each other. The Market will do their best as to have specific protocols in place for entry/ exiting the Market. And to assure adequate spacing between shoppers.

Some requirements for the 2021 FFM season may include, but are not limited to:

- **Masks may be** required for all Market staff, vendors, and shoppers in accordance with orders from the Washington State Secretary of Health.
- Vendors are responsible for maintaining social distancing at their booths.
- No product sampling until further notice, except for take-away sealed samples.
- Vendors will do their best to clean and sanitize surfaces in their booth.
- Vendors will have a hand-wash station if applicable for their specific operation.
- Hand sanitizer inside each vendor booth is highly recommended.
- Vendors will display any signage provided to them by FFM as required.
- Vendors are responsible for complying with all COVID-19 requirements that apply to their vendor operations at FFM, whether or not a requirement is listed on this sheet.
- FFM will insist Vendors stay home when they are sick.
- We encourage those in a high-risk category to continue wearing a mask.
