IWLA encourages its members to get involved in the political process. The easiest and most effective way to do that is to vote! If you're not already a registered voter, now is the time to get registered. In Pennsylvania, the state has a "one-stop" web site (www.votespa.com) where you can register to vote, request a mail-in or absentee ballot, check on your voter registration status, find your polling place, etc. All voter registration applications must be received by Oct. 19, if you want to vote on Nov. 3. The upcoming elections will determine the decisions our local, state, and federal government make in the upcoming years. So remember, if you don't vote on Nov. 3, don't complain on Nov. 4!

Hi Juniors!

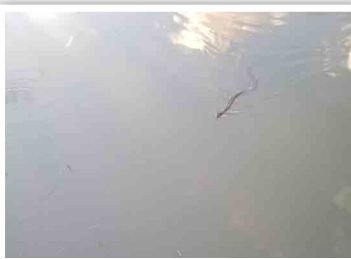

LAKE TONIAN

Whew, it's been a warm summer season this year. While information about the fishing at the pond was scarce for the last few months, we have had some "action" going on. In our quest for better water quality, Garrett Boop was successful in removing two snapping turtles from the pond (approx. 6 and 15lbs.) There have been additional snapping turtle(s) sighted, so there is more work to be done with those residents. There is an over-abundance of Eastern Painted turtles that we will be addressing as well. While their presence isn't necessarily a bad thing, the extreme numbers we have is detrimental to our management plan.

The fishing itself has picked up greatly over the last two(2) weeks of August. Jacob LaPorta, age 8, is being highlighted this month with his astonishing bluegill catch. He had his sights on possibly catching a catfish from the pond, but was quickly redirected when he hooked into the fish pictured. His experience is exactly what the management program was designed to do. Both his father and himself have been talking about his catch; a panfish worthy of classifying Jacob as a Master Angler nationally. The best part: this fish is still living in the pond just waiting to give someone else their catch of a lifetime! (Nicely done Jacob!)

The other picture shown was somewhat troubling. We are a conservation club, there is absolutely no reason I should be cleaning up live bait containers from our own

waterway! I was initially against the use of live bait in the pond for a multitude of reasons; trash in/around the pond being one of them. Please, carry out what you carry in and keep the grounds clean for our purpose and for everyone's utmost enjoyment.
