The discount after midyear only applies to new members.

Secondary Note: Reminder that 2017 dues include the onetime \$20 assessment that was previously announced for the 2016 mower acquisition. Life members required to pay the \$20 fee.

Treasurers' Report:

The Treasurer's report was read and was approved. We still have money. :)

Prior Months Meeting Minutes:

The Club's February meeting minutes were read by Bruce and approved by the attending members.

Old Business:

Remember to signed up / renew with AMA before you fly.

Jim Rippy reported that the manager for the Fern Creek Library Brain Reynolds is excited to hold an aircraft display for the club. Jim noted that the room is large and has a TV with VCR/DVD player that can be used to share our club pictures, videos, Web site or even used with a Simulator, This is a great way to get new members involved. Brian suggested doing it in November during Aviation History Month. The display would be set up by the club for up to a week timeframe. The room would be locked after our members leave for the day. Gary will add the subject to the September meeting for planning purposes.

Gary and team completed the installation of a new entrance barrier at the field gate. Gary noted that the Marathon pipeline team representatives were very prompt in attending the work site when notified. We used the underground marking service as prescribed by Marathon. Their representative indicated that the pipe line is a 8" pipe that is only berried 32" under the surface. PS we put the new posts in at 24". Whew, we are glad we called! Gary noted that if someone is seen digging over the pipe line without approval from Marathon, they can be fined up to \$1,500. The line pushed gasoline and diesel fuel from Louisville to Lexington.

2nd Annual Fix & Fly Day:

The club would like to have most of the ruts and mole holes repaired sooner than later this spring. The attendees decided that we would combine the first Fun Fly on April 15th with the field repair so that the field would be ready for rolling. We will be looking for volunteers to use the wheel barrel, shovel, and rake kept in the club house or you can bring your own. Club members don't have to wait until the work day to use the tools and dirt to fix the holes. See attached flyer for more details. The expectation is that we will contact Flynn Brothers for an April 17th or the 24th rolling.

New Business:

A new blower was purchased to help with grounds maintenance.

The gate lock code will be changed this Saturday (3/11/17) to the new 2017 code,
