

The BC/AD system for designating dates before or after the birth of Christ was devised by a monk Dionysius Exiguus in 525 AD. He incorrectly placed the birth of Jesus in 1 BC because of an old text that placed his birth in the 28th year of the reign of Augustus Caesar. Augustus was accepted as emperor four years before the official ceremony, So, Jesus was probably born in 5 or 6 BC.
