

Prefer to provide free rides to women, instead of buying Rs 191 crore-plane: Arvind Kejriwal takes jibe at Gujarat CM

New Delhi: Taking a veiled dig at his Gujarat counterpart Vijay Rupani, Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal on Sunday said that instead of buying a Rs 191 crore-plane for himself he preferred to provide free ride to women in public transport buses.

He said that opposition parties were getting "uncomfortable" by his government's schemes for facilitating people. "We allowed free travel to women in public transport buses and the opposition raised noise over it. People ask where did the money for it come from. The chief minister of a state bought a plane worth Rs 191 crore for himself. I did not buy a plane and instead made travel free for my sisters," Kejriwal said at Rithala here. The women in Delhi have been allowed free travel in public transport buses by the AAP government

from October 29. The move coming a few months before the Delhi Assembly polls due early next year has been criticised by the BJP as a "freebie" for political gains. Inaugurating construction of roads in Rohini under Rithala Assembly

constituency, Kejriwal said opposition parties were not happy with his government's schemes for the people.

"We made 200 units of power consumption free and opposition leaders are opposing it. Their MPs get free 4,000 units free, but if a driver gets it, they are pained," he said. The chief minister said that cost of road construction will be




brought down by reusing old road material. He said the new roads will be constructed by digging up the old ones and reusing the dug up material. He said the technique will save 30 per cent of construction cost. The technique which will overcome the problem of uneven road surface, was available earlier but was not employed due to corruption, he said

Saudi, UAE discuss \$70 billion crude refinery project in India

Saudi Arabia and the United Arab Emirates discussed a planned refinery in the western Indian state of Maharashtra that will cost at least \$70 billion, a figure that exceeds the initial \$44 billion estimate previously announced.

The new figure came from a





The statement said the two sides discussed the initiative, first announced in 2018, to develop the refinery and petrochemicals complex, which would secure the supply of 600,000 barrels per day of Saudi and Emirati crude oil for India's market.

The project, which would be run by a consortium that includes Saudi Aramco and ADNOC, has yet to begin or secure land.

Jordan retakes lands leased by Israel in 1994 peace accord

AMMAN, Jordan (AP) -- Jordan's king announced that his country is retaking "full sovereignty" over two pieces of land leased by Israel, reflecting the cool relations between the neighboring countries as they mark the 25th anniversary of their landmark peace deal.

King Abdullah II had said last year that he wouldn't renew the parts of the 1994 treaty that gave Israel a 25-year lease of the two small areas, Baqura and Ghamr. Even amid mistrust and a looming deadline, Israel was hoping a solution could be found.

But in a speech to parliament, the king appeared to put an end to that.

"Today, I announce the expiration of the Peace Treaty annexes on Ghamr and al-Baqura and the imposition of our full sovereignty over every inch of those lands," he said.

The Israeli and Jordanian foreign ministries announced that Israeli farmers would be allowed to harvest this season's crops in Ghamr, known in Hebrew as Tsofar. They also said that Jordan would respect private land ownership rights at Baqura, or Naharayim in Hebrew.

But Jordan's Foreign Ministry said farmers would require a visa and have to enter through the country through official border crossings, instead of the former system in which they could simply enter the areas freely.

"Israel regrets Jordan's decision to ter-

minate the annexes," the Israeli Foreign Ministry said.

The announcement marked a new blow to relations that, after the treaty, began with great optimism but have steadily deteriorated. Jordan's agreement is only the second peace deal between Israel and an Arab country, following Egypt.

The accord remains a vital strategic asset for both countries, which maintain tight security cooperation and joint economic projects. But Israel's occupation of the West Bank and its policies in east Jerusalem, where Jordan has custodial rights over Muslim holy sites, have repeatedly raised tensions over the years.

In Jordan, where over half the population are believed to be Palestinian refugees or their descendants, public opinion has remained largely against normalized relations with Israel.

Just two weeks ago, Jordan recalled its ambassador to Israel in protest against the detention of two Jordanians for suspected security offenses. They were released last week after being held for two months. They were detained while entering the West Bank from Jordan through an Israelicontrolled crossing.

Baqura and Ghamr were leased to Jewish farmers early last century.

They became part of Jordan after the kingdom gained independence from Britain in 1946.

The Pakistan government wants to reclaim temples and hand them over to the Hindu community. The government has decided to reclaim and restore 400 temples to the Hindu citizens of Pakistan. Pakistan's federal government has decided to reopen Hindu temples across the country in phases, fulfilling the longstanding demand of the minority Hindus that their places of worship be restored to them. When most Hindus left Pakistan during Partition, many temples were lost to encroachment; even in places where some Hindu families stayed back, local strongmen muscled in and occupied temple land. Many temple complexes ended up being used as a common facility and some even became madrassas.

Now the Pakistan government wants to reclaim temples and hand them over to the Hindu community. The government has decided to reclaim and restore 400 temples to the Hindu citizens of Pakistan.

The process will begin with two historic shrines in Sialkot and Peshawar. Sialkot has a functioning Jagannath Temple and now the 1,000-year-old Shivalaya Teja Singh is set to be restored. Hindus had stopped visiting the shivalaya (shawala) after a mob attack during Babri mosque demolition protests in 1992. In Peshawar, the Pakistani courts had ordered reopening of the Gorakhnath Temple and it's been declared a heritage site.

From now on, two to three such historic and heritage temple complexes will be restored by the government of Pakistan every year.

Earlier, the All-Pakistan Hindu Rights Movement conducted a survey across the country and the result shocked everyone. The survey found there were 428 Hindu temples at the time of Partition and 408 of them were turned into toy stores, restaurants, government offices and schools after 1990.

According to a recent government estimate, at least 11 temples in Sindh, four in Punjab, three in Balochistan and two in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa were operational in



2019.

Pakistan recently agreed to open the Kartarpur Sahib corridor to facilitate pilgrimage to Guru Nanak's birthplace from Punjab on the Indian side. The Pakistan government has also approved a proposal to establish a corridor that will allow Hindu pilgrims to visit Sharda Peeth, an ancient Saraswati temple in Pakistan-Occupied Kashmir. Still teaching at 95, Jimmy Carter draws devotees to church

PLAINS, Ga. (AP) — The pilgrims arrive early and from all over, gathering hours before daybreak in an old pecan grove that surrounds a country church. They come, they say, for a dose of simple decency and devotion wrapped up in a Bible lesson.

The teacher is the 39th president of the United States, Jimmy Carter.

Nearly four decades after he left office and despite a body that's failing after 95 years, the nation's oldest-ever ex-president still teaches Sunday school roughly twice a month at Maranatha Baptist Church in his tiny hometown of Plains in southwest Georgia. His message is unfailingly about Jesus, not himself.

The church has only 30 or so members, but as many as 450 people attend any week Carter teaches. About 200 people fill the sanctuary, with pale-green walls and stained glass windows, and others gather in side rooms where the lesson is shown on TVs.

It's nearly impossible to separate even an ex-president from politics, and some come because they're Democrats who recall voting for Carter when he was elected in 1976. Almost uniformly, they're dismayed by the tone of President Donald Trump and his Republican administration.

But Trump has only been in office since 2017 and Carter has been drawing crowds for years. Those who attended Carter's most recent lesson on Nov. 3 said they just wanted to be in the presence of someone who seems kind, humble and godly despite having been a world leader.

"He's a role model and an inspiration for both of us both in public service and in faith," said visitor Doug Kluth. He and his wife Ramona drove 2,400 miles (3,862 kilometers) round trip from their home in Columbus, Nebraska, to see Carter in person. John and Sarah Dyer packed their four daughters, ages 2 through 12, into their Honda Pilot for the 1,700-mile (2,736-kilometer) round trip to Plains from suburban Chicago.

"To see a man who was once on top of the world choose to spend his twilight years lifting the world higher was inspirational to my family and I," John Dyer wrote to the church's pastor in a letter shared with The Associated Press.

Carter faced mockery for his Southern Baptist faith in 1976 when he said in a Playboy magazine interview that he was guilty of adultery in his heart because he lusted after women. The soul-baring sentiment paralleled Jesus' words in the Sermon on the Mount, but it came across as odd and narrow-minded to many.

These days, with a twice-divorced president who curses in public and once said he'd never asked God for forgiveness, Carter's approach to life — with his wife of 73 years, Rosalynn, by his side — seems especially appealing to fans.

They say they admire Carter's work to eradicate disease and monitor elections worldwide; the time he has spent helping build homes as a volunteer with Habitat for Humanity; and his advocacy for food programs and rural health care in his home county. Many were touched by photos of a bruised-but-smiling Carter performing volunteer work after he fell and hit his head in October.

So they flock to Plains any week Maranatha Baptist posts on its website or Facebook page that Carter plans to teach.

Fray and Susan Carter of Russellville, Alabama, slept overnight in their car in the church parking lot to get a front-row view as Carter taught on his first Sunday back after falling and breaking his pelvis in October.

As recently as last year Carter would stand during his 45-minute lesson, but he now uses an electric lift chair at the front of the sanctuary as a concession to age. He breaks into that familiar smile when he raises the seat so he can see the crowd over a wooden lectern. A cross made by Carter, a longtime woodworker, adorns the choir loft. He also made the wooden offering plates, which bear his initials on the bottom.

Carter's lesson this day was on his belief in life after death. He ended the same way he always does, by challenging class members to do one nice thing for somebody over the next month.

"That's what I think would make America a better country. It would make you a better person, right? And a better Christian," Carter said. "Well, that's the essence of my Sunday school lesson. Not anything fancy to it. Just some personal things to think about."

Visitors that day included people from multiple U.S. states plus Venezuela and Ecuador. Rarely a week goes by without someone from overseas in the crowd, said the Rev. Tony Lowden, Carter's pastor.

The church was formed in 1977 from a split when another church refused to accept blacks as members. Lowden was hired in March as Maranatha's first black pastor. On any given Sunday, Lowden said, the congregation is a "mix of everything."

"It's a melting pot of people who are looking for faith and looking for something that they can believe in," Lowden said. After a cancer diagnosis in 2015 and three falls this year, it's unclear how much longer Carter can continue to teach, but Lowden said he's welcome as long as he's able.



The crowd on the first Sunday in November included Chet Mulholland, an evangelical Christian from Wisconsin, and Joey and Sabrina Fretwell, faithful churchgoers from conservative Mississippi in the heart of the Deep South. The couple's daughter attended a Trump rally in Tupelo, Mississippi, just two days before they drove to Plains to see Carter.

Sabrina Fretwell, 46, doesn't really remember Carter's presidency, but she recalls hours spent listening to her grandparents talk about Carter when she was a girl. That's one reason she wanted to see the former president, she said, to somehow honor that time.

"I remember that warm feeling of sitting and listening to their conversations, and not being old enough to grab what they were talking about but knowing it was still important to them and knowing they admired the things he was doing," she said.

Ilhan Omar pleads for compassion for man who threatened her life

Congresswoman Ilhan Omar has a message for the judge who will decide the fate of the man who threatened to kill her: she wants restorative justice.

Patrick Carlineo called Omar's office in the middle of the day on 21 March and got through to one of her staffers. On the call, Carlineo is said to have accused Omar of being a terrorist, before saying: "Why are you working for her, she's a (expletive) terrorist. Somebody ought to put a bullet in her skull. Back in the day, our forefathers would have put a bullet in her (expletive)." (US attorneys removed the actual expletives in their filing.)

Carlineo pleaded guilty to the offense today.

In a letter to Judge Frank Geraci, who will decide on the case, Omar pleaded for com-

passion for Carlineo.

In a two-page open letter, Omar began by stressing the seriousness of his crime.

"As someone who fled a war zone, I know how destabilizing acts of political violence can be. That his threat of violence relied on hateful stereotypes about my faith only made it more dangerous ... It was a threat against an entire religion, at a time of rising hate crime against religious minorities in our country," she said.

Noting that those who commit acts of violence have often been victims of alienation and neglect themselves, Omar said that compassion, not retribution, might be the only way to rehabilitate him:

"We must ask: who are we as a nation if we respond to acts of political retribution with retribution ourselves? The answer to hate is not more hate; it is compassion," she wrote.

Omar suggested that community integration and social services would serve Carlineo better than a long prison sentence or a hefty fine. If convicted, his alleged crime could carry a sentence of up to 10 years in prison, and a \$250,000 fine.

"Punishing the defendant with a lengthy prison sentence or a burdensome financial fine would not rehabilitate him. It would not repair the harm he has caused. It would only increase his anger and resentment," wrote Omar.

She ended by saying that although acts of political violence are increasing, that anger




and exclusion is not the solution. She quoted Nelson Mandela, who once said: "People must learn to hate, and if they can learn to hate they can be taught to love."

She ended by pleading with the judge: "I ask you to show compassion in your sentencing." **INTERNATIONAL PAGES**

Dec 2019 Safety Share - Winter Driving Awareness

Winter driving brings its own set of hazards which can be avoided by slowing down and following safe practices. Remain aware of the hazards of steering and braking requirements while driving in wintery conditions.

• Slowdown in snow, sleet, icy and wet conditions. Buckle up, cruise control off and turn lights on for safety. Steering

Steering is safer than braking at speeds above 25mph because less distance is required to steer around an object than to brake to a stop. Ensure you keep your hands at 3 and 9 o'clock on the steering wheel.

• Push-Pull-Slide-This method is performed over fixed hand steering by shuffling your hands so that neither hand crosses over the imaginary line between 12 and 6 o'clock. Since the arms never cross, you can provide

continuous adjustments in either direction.

• Fixed Hand Steering - This method allows for rapid 180-degree steering to either condition, but it has one

shortcoming. This method is confining. Your arms may be locked together as you attempt to steer past 180-

degrees, leaving you in an awkward position to make further fine adjustments. Braking

The stopping distance required on ice at 10°F is twice the amount required above 33°F. Slow down ... Your vehicle speed should be based on current conditions regardless of posted speed limit. Sudden braking can lead to loss of control.

• Black Ice - You can rarely see it ... but it could exist in shady spots, on bridges and overpasses and in intersections. Ice is most likely to form in

these areas first or be the most slippery. • Enhance Focus Based on Conditions

- Focus your attention as far ahead as pos-

sible, at least 20 to 30 seconds ahead of you. When the conditions change, so does your braking space requirement. You will need to lengthen your following distance and increase your space cushion.

• Braking without Anti-Lock Brakes -Threshold braking ... keep the heel of your foot on the floor and use the ball of your foot to apply firm, steady pressure on the brake pedal to the threshold of

locking your brakes. Remember to keep your heel on the floor

to prevent using your thigh muscles which are incapable of the finer control offered by using your ankle. • Braking with Anti-Lock Brakes (ABS) -Do not remove your foot from the brake. When you apply the brakes hard

enough to make the wheels lock, you will feel the brake pedal vibrate and pulse back against your foot. The system is working as it was designed to work. Do not pump the pedal or remove your foot from the brake. Skids

Skidding occurs when you apply the brakes so hard that one or more wheels lock or if you press hard on the



If you are happy and you know it... you may live longer

Plenty of research suggests optimistic people have a reduced risk of heart disease, stroke, and declines in lung capacity and function. Optimism is also associated with a lower risk of early death from cancer and infection. And now a new study links optimism to living a longer life.

What does this new research on optimism tell us?

The study in Proceedings of the National Academy of Sciences found that people who had higher levels of optimism had a longer life span. They also had a greater chance of living past age 85. The researchers analyzed data gleaned from two large population studies: about 70,000 women from the Nurses' Health Study and about 1,400 men from the Veterans Affairs Normative Aging Study.

The Nurses' Health Study used items from the Life Orientation Test to assess optimism. The measure asks respondents to rate their level of agreement to several statements about optimism. The Normative Aging Study relied on the Optimism-Pessimism Scale, administered as part of a personality assessment. This scale examines the positive and negative explanations people give for events in their life.

For both men and women, higher levels

of optimism were associated with a longer life span and "exceptional longevity," which the researchers defined as surviving to 85. The study controlled for factors like chronic physical conditions (such as hypertension or high cholesterol) and health behaviors (such as smoking or alcohol use).

There were several limitations to the study results. For example, participants were largely white and had higher socioeconomic status than the general population. These factors may limit whether the findings apply to a wide range of people.

So why might optimism affect longevity? The study wasn't designed to explain this, but the researchers had several thoughts. While one component of optimism appears to be heritable - that is, tied to our genes — our environment and learning also shape a significant portion. One takeaway is that we can all learn ways to be more optimistic.

How can you become more optimistic? Whether you're naturally optimistic or not, you can take certain steps in that direction.

Reframe situations. When some people confront difficulties, they tend to only

Broccoli is high in both choline and vitamin K. These nutrients contribute to memory function and focus. The veggie also has a lot of vitamin C and fiber. Practice gratitude meditations. Gratitude meditations focus on giving thanks for the positive aspects of your life, which can include family members, friends, or possessions, among other things. You can find numerous scripts and guided meditations available online.

to strong social networks. A strong social network can include spending time with close friends, or participating in regularly scheduled group or community activities. Joining new groups or scheduling time to see friends and family and engage in activities strengthens these relationships. Focus on spending time with positive and supportive people.

Practice the half-smile. A psychotherapy technique to cope with sad feelings is to practice smiling for a few minutes each day. If a full smile is not possible, a halfsmile works as well. Notice any impact on your thoughts, mood, and level of optimism.

Emperor Jahangir (1569 - 1627)

Nur-ud-deen Muhammad Salim, later known as Jahangir (born August 31, 1569 in Fatehpur Sikri, India and died October 28, 1627 while enroute from Kashmir to Lahore, Pakistan) was the fourth Mughal Emperor of India and ruled from 1605 to 1627. He was born to Emperor Akbar's first Hindu wife, Jodha Bai (also know as Harkha) daughter of Raja Bharmal of Jaipur. Before Salim, all of Akbar's children had died in infancy, and it was his great desire to have a son. Every year Akbar paid a visit to the shrine of Moinuddin Chisti at Sikri. During this period, Shaikh Salim Chisti, the venerable sage whose saintliness and austere penances drew to him may admiring disciples from far and near also lived in Sikri. On August 31, 1569, Jodha Bai gave birth to a boy, it was commonly believed that this was due to the supplications of Shaikh Salim Chisti. The child was named Salim after the saint, though, Akbar always addressed him as Shaikhu Baba. The blessings of Shaikh Salim Chisti so filled the heart of Akbar with gratitude that he decided to leave Agra and move his court to Sikri. Here, in the course of time a large city grew up; however, it was eventually abandoned. Salim became estranged from his father and revolted in 1599 while Akbar was engaged in the Deccan. Father and son later reconciled and Akbar confirmed Jahangir as his successor on his deathbed in October 1605. Jahangir ascended the throne on October 24, 1605 in the midst of great rejoicings. His liberal education, his natural shewedness and his strong commonsense well qualified him to carry on his father's liberal policies. Soon after this accession he caused the famous chain of justice to be fastened between the Shaahburj in the Fort of Agra and a pillar on the bank of the Jumna. A war with the Rajput principality of Mewar was ended in 1614 on generous

terms.

Campaigns against Ahmadnagar, initiated under Akbar's rule, were continued fitfully, with Mughal arms and diplomacy often thwarted by the able Habshi (slave), Malik Ambār. In 1617 and 1621, however, Prince Khurram (later Shah Jahan) concluded apparently victorious peace treaties. Jahāngīr, like his father, was not a

strict Sunni Muslim; he allowed, for example, the Jesuits to dispute publicly with Muslim 'Ulema' (theologians) and to

make converts. Among his four sons, Khusrau, Parwiz, Khurram (Shah Jahan) and Shahryar, Khusrau caused the most problems and constantly rebelling against his father and committing atrocities in the process, He was eventually captured and thrown in prison. Prince Khurram also rebelled against Jahangir in 1625, but father and son were later reconciled. In 1611, Jahangir married Mehrunnissa (later known as Nur Jehan), the widow of Ali Quli Khan (Sher Afgan), one of his Persian emirs. Her father, the

Persian born Itimad-ud-daula,

became his closest advisor-cumminister, her brother Asaf Khan (the father of the future emperor, Shah Jehan's wife Mumtaz Mahal) was one of his most

successful generals and Nur Jehan herself in a short period of time began to wield great power over Jahangir and

eventually became the supreme soverign during periods of imperial incapacity. Nur Jahan influence should have extended into the next reign. Her brother, Asaf Khan, stood by Shah Jahan and duly became his closest advisor when he succeded. Nur Jahan cast her lot with Prince Shahriyar, one of Shah Jahan's brohers and rivals, who was married to Ladli Begum, her daughter from her first marriage. On Jahangir's death, Shahriyar, aided by Nur Jahan,

made his bid for power. He was outwitted by Asaf Khan, then defeated and murdered. Nur Jahan's days as the power behind the throne were over. Instead, she concentrated on charity work and on erecting a tomb for her father,

Itimad-ud-daula, who had died just before Jahangir. Nur Jahan also designed her own and Jahangir's tombs in Shahdara, in Lahore (Pakistan).

Jahangir is one of the most interesting figures in Mughal history. The ordinary view that he was a sensual pleasure seeker and a callous tyrant does him less than justice. All accounts agree that he was intelligent, shrewed and capable of understanding the most complex problems of state without any difficulty. His vices included consuming wine and opium from an early age which entually lead to his early demise.



Having Begun Life as Bus Conductor': AIADMK's Reminder for Rajinikanth After His Dig at CM

A day after Rajinikanth referred to "wonder and miracle" as the reason behind the survival of the Palaniswami government, the AIADMK on Tuesday hit back at the actor-turned-politician.

The AIADMK, in its party mouthpiece 'Namadhu Amma', said: "You [Rajinikanth] would not have dreamt to become a Superstar. Having begun your life as a bus conductor." The article added that Edappadi K Palaniswami was not a reel but "real leader who has won elections and only then got the chief minister's position". The party was miffed by Rajinikanth's speech on Sunday at an event to celebrate actor Kamal Haasan's 60 years in Indian cinema.

In a clip that went viral, Rajinikanth said: "Miracles and wonders do happen in politics. Who would have thought that Edappadi Palaniswami would have become the CM? Even after he became the CM, most people said his government would topple in 20 days or one month... some said it won't last for more than four to five months. But due to some miracle and wonder, he is the chief minister for two years now. Miracles and wonders happened yesterday, they are happening today and they will happen tomorrow too."

The AIADMK had recently lashed out at both Rajinikanth and Kamal Haasan for their political ambitions and said they would meet a fate similar to that faced by actor Sivaji Ganesan in politics. The attack came after Rajinikanth said there was space for new leadership in the

Gotabaya Rajapaksa elected Sri Lankan president: Narendra Modi congratulates ex-defence secretary, says he looks forward to deepening 'fraternal ties'

After former Sri Lankan defence secretary Gotabaya Rajapaksa was declared victorious in Sri Lanka's presidential election on Sunday, Prime Minister Narendra Modi congratulated him and the people of Sri Lanka and expressed a wish to deepen "fraternal ties

Gotabaya responded, "I thank Prime Minister Narendra Modi and the people of India for your warm wishes. Our two nations are bound by history and common beliefs and I look forward to strengthening our friendship and meeting you in the near future."

Sri Lanka's ruling party presidential candidate, Housing Minister Sajith Premadasa, earlier conceded defeat to Gotabaya, saying he would honor the decision of the people.

Gotabaya, a former defense official revered by Sri Lanka's ethnic majority for his role in ending a bloody civil war but feared by minorities for his brutal approach, is the brother of former president Mahinda Rajapaksa.

Gotabaya has pledged to restore security to the Indian Ocean island nation still recovering from Islamic State-inspired attacks last Easter.

Gotabaya's victory marks the return of a family ousted from power in 2015 elections amid constant reports of nepotism, skimming off development deals with China and alleged human rights violations during the end of the decades-long war with the Tamil Tiger rebels in 2009.

Rajya Sabha MP Subramanian Swamy. and Pakistan's foreign ministry spokesperson Mohammed Faisal also congratulated Gotabaya:

Gotabaya accepted support from Bud-

dhist nationalist clerics who demanded the resignation of Muslim Cabinet members and governors they claimed were interfering with the investigation of the Easter attacks.

Flanked by Buddhist monks at campaign events, Gotabaya focused his message on Sri Lanka's majority Sinhala Buddhist population, who comprise about 70 percent of the island's citizens.

Gotabaya's victory will also be a blow to the post-civil war reconciliation process and truth-seeking on alleged wartime abuses by both government troops and the Tamil Tiger rebels. In the lead up to the election, Gotabaya said that he would not honor a United Nations human rights resolution to investigate alleged abuses.



Gotabaya pledged to appoint as prime minister his brother Mahinda, who was briefly installed as prime minister last year, when outgoing President Maithripala Sirisena fired the sitting prime minister Ranil Wickremesinghe over political differences.

On the call, Carlineo is said to have accused Omar of being a terrorist, before saying: "Why are you working for her, she's a (expletive) terrorist. Somebody ought to put a bullet in her skull. Back in the day, our forefathers would have put a bullet in her (expletive)." (US attorneys removed the actual expletives in their filing.)

Carlineo pleaded guilty to the offense today.

In a letter to Judge Frank Geraci, who will decide on the case, Omar pleaded for compassion for Carlineo.

In a two-page open letter, Omar began by

stressing the seriousness of his crime.

"As someone who fled a war zone, I know how destabilizing acts of political violence can be. That his threat of violence relied on hateful stereotypes about my faith only made it more dangerous ... It was a threat against an entire religion, at a time of rising hate crime against religious minorities in our country," she said. Noting that those who commit acts of violence have often been victims of alienation and neglect themselves, Omar said that compassion, not retribution, might be the only way to rehabilitate him:

"We must ask: who are we as a nation if we respond to acts of political retribution with retribution ourselves? The answer to hate is not more hate; it is compassion," she wrote.

Omar suggested that community integration and social services would serve Carlineo better than a long prison sentence

or a hefty fine. If convicted, his alleged crime could carry a sentence of up to 10 years in prison, and a \$250,000 fine.

"Punishing the defendant with a lengthy prison sentence or a burdensome financial fine would not rehabilitate him. It would not repair

the harm he has caused. It would only increase his anger and resentment," wrote Omar.

She ended by saying that although acts of political violence are increasing, that anger and exclusion is not the solution. She quoted Nelson Mandela, who once said: "People must learn to hate, and if



they can learn to hate they can be taught to love."

She ended by pleading with the judge: "I ask you to show compassion in your sentencing." https://www.indiatoday.in/ INTERNATIONAL PAG



US Government Proposes Steep Fee Hikes for Citizenship, Legal Permanent Residency, I-131 Form Travel Document

As the year 2019 is approaching its end, the Trump administration is hardening its stance towards citizenship and legal permanent residency for immigrants in the US. In October 2019, the US government revised the fee waiver policy for US citizenship applicants, which have left thousands of green card holders unable to become citizens. As a result, the US Citizenship and Immigration Services announced a change to the Form I-912, which low-income legal permanent residents can use to apply for US citizenship without paying the \$725 filing fee.

Notably, one out of every seven Indian-origin legal permanent residents lives below the federal poverty line.

On top of the change to the Form I-912, the Trump administration has officially proposed a steep hike in the costs for immigrants to become legal permanent residents or citizens in the US. The proposal

seeks an 83% increase in the fees associated with the citizenship application process and a 79% increase in the costs associated with the legal permanent residency, under the pretext that current fees fall short of recovering the costs of providing adjudication and naturalization services. The US citizenship application fees would now jump from \$640 to \$1170, which about 40% of applicants may not be able to afford. On the other hand, the fees for the legal permanent residency filing process would leapfrog to \$2195. Also, the cost of applying for marriage-based green cards within the US would increase by 56%, from \$1760 to \$2750.

The Trump administration has also proposed introducing a fee for asylum seekers. Those applying for asylum in the United States would now have to pay \$50; this makes the US one of the 4 countries to take fees from asylum seekers. The proposal also targets recipients of the DACA

(Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals) program for a significant increase in the fees, from \$495 to \$765, for their protection renewal applications.

Removal of certain fees, such as the cost for obtaining one's fingerprints (biometrics) has been proposed by the Trump administration. On the other hand, the Form I-131 or Ap-

plication for Travel Document that those on the green card wait list need to travel abroad would no more come for free, under the new proposal. Anyone traveling abroad while awaiting the green card will have to pay \$585 for the Form I-131.

While Trump's critics and immigration advocates find the fees-increasing proposal a fresh measure to restrict legal immigration; Ken Cuccinelli, the acting director of



USCIS, opined that the proposed fee hikes would help the underfunded agency run its operations without any financial obstacle. USCIS is underfunded by USD 1.3 billion a year, according to him. Notably, 95% of the revenue for USCIS comes from various application fees.

Punjab: Dalit labourer who was beaten up, 'forced to drink urine' dies

NINE DAYS after he was allegedly beaten up and forced to drink urine, Jagmale Singh (37), a Dalit labourer of Changali Wala village in Sangrur district of Punjab, succumbed to his injuries on Saturday.

All the four accused — Amarjeet Singh, his son Rinku, and the latter's friends, Lucky and Binder — have been arrested. The four, all residents of the same village, had reportedly targeted Jagmale following an altercation on October 21. All of them belong to the Jat Sikh community.

"We arrested Amarjeet, Rinku and Lucky on November 14, while Binder was arrested on November 15. On questioning, they claimed that the victim had abused them," said Sangrur SSP Sandeep Garg. The four accused have been booked for murder and under the SC/ ST Act.

According to Jagmale's statement to the police, as quoted in the FIR, he was taken to Rinku's house and beaten up on November 7. "I was tied to a pole for twothree hours. Beeta alias Binder had a stick in his hand, Rinku was holding my arms, while his father Amarjeet was carrying a small rod. They beat me up mercilessly...

When I asked Rinku to give me water, he went to the bathroom, urinated, and made me drink his urine," Jagmale said in his statement.

According to the FIR, the medical report noted that the injuries were caused by a blunt weapon.

"On October 21, my husband had an altercation with Rinku, Binder and his friends. However, the matter was resolved. But on November 7, Rinku, Binder and Lucky took my husband to Amarjeet's house and beat him up," Jagmale's wife, Manjeet Kaur (32), told The Sunday Express. The couple have three children — a 15-year-old son and two daughters aged 9 and 6 years.

"He was tied to a pole and beaten up. His legs were broken after being hit with rods and sticks, and injuries were inflicted with a screwdriver. Acid was poured on his injuries. When he asked for water, he was forced to drink urine," alleged Jagmale's nephew, Gurdeep Thandiwal.

After being beaten up, Jagmale was reportedly left on a street near his house. He remained at his house for three days. On November 10, as his condition deteriorated, he was taken to a nearby hospital. "Police came to know about the incident on November 10, when Jagmale was taken to hospital," said SSP Garg.

Jagmale gave his statement to the police on November 13, and a case was filed.

Jagmale, meanwhile, was first shifted to Rajindra Medical College, Patiala, and later to PGIMER, Chandigarh, where his legs were amputated on Friday. "The victim came to PGI on November 13. The doctors amputated both his legs as the infection had spread... Subsequently, his vital organs also got infected," said an official at PGIMER.

"A couple of years ago, Rinku had beaten me up as well ... Both my arms were broken... I am still not able to work properly," said Jagmale's brother, Gurtej Singh.

"Police are taking action against the culprits. The Department of Welfare of SCs and BCs gives Rs 8.25 lakh as compensation in such cases," said DC Ghanshyam Thori.

The Zamin Prapati Sangrash Commit-



tee, an organisation which fights for the rights of Dalits, has demanded Rs 25 lakh as compensation to Jagmale's family and a government job for his wife. "Atrocities against Dalits are continuing, as the upper caste people are not punished... We will block the Jakhal-Sangrur highway on Sunday if the government is not ready to give in to our demands," Mukesh Malaud, president of the organisation, said.

"We are shocked to hear about the incident... we recommend financial help to the family," Tejinder Kaur, chairperson of the Punjab SC/ST Commission said. Saurabh Prashar, Raakhi Jagga

Bihar: Man declared dead in mob lynching returns home

Patna (Bihar) [India], Nov 17 (ANI): Krishna Manjhi, who was declared dead in a mob lynching case reported in August this year, has returned to his home around a week back.

"I was not able to identify his body. It was in a decomposed state when the incident of mob lynching took place three months back. The villagers confirmed the body was of my husband as he was wearing similar clothes. Now, my husband has returned alive," said Rudi Devi, wife of Krishna Manjhi.

A person was beaten to death by a mob on August 10 in Mahmatpur village on charges of child theft.

The deceased was then identified as Krishna Manjhi, a resident of Nisarpura village of Rani Talab police station. His family had reported to the police that he had been missing for a long time.

After the post-mortem examination, the body was handed over to Krishna's family. The family duly cremated the body but after about three months, Krishna returned home alive to utter surprise and happiness of his family.

"A mob lynching case was reported on August 10, 2019, under Naubatpur police station. The family of Krishna Manjhi had identified the body. The recent development is that Krishna Manjhi has returned home," said Garima Malik, Senior Superintendent of Police, Patna, while talking to reporters.

"We will now investigate who was the per-

China Defends Crackdown on Muslims, and Criticizes Times Article

BEIJING - The Chinese government on Monday portrayed the country's crackdown in the western region of Xinjiang as a great success against terrorism, trying to counter renewed international criticism prompted by a New York Times article detailing the internal deliberations that led to the mass detention of Muslims in re-education camps and prisons. A spokesman for the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Geng Shuang, criticized the newspaper's report, published on Sunday, saying the article smeared China's efforts against extremism. But he did not dispute the authenticity of the leaked internal documents that confirmed the coercive nature of the measures used against Uighurs and other Turkic Muslims in western China over the past three years.

A statement from the Xinjiang regional government of China was far more strident, saying the Times article had been "completely fabricated by hostile forces at home and abroad" and calling it "total nonsense and a pack of lies, with sinister motives behind it." The regional government's statement did not specifically deny the authenticity of the documents on which the article was based, but repeatedly attacked what it described as fictitious reporting by The Times.

"Concocting fake news to attract eyeballs is a habitual trick of America's New York Times, and this newspaper suffered a crisis of credibility for its fakery," the statement said. "This time, America's New York Times has again fabricated and concocted fake news about Xinjiang. This is nothing more than getting up to its old tricks, and is completely unworthy of refutation. This despicable conduct will surely be met with the contempt of wiser minds in the international community."

In a statement, a spokeswoman for The Times, Danielle Rhoades Ha, said: "Our story is based on more than 400 pages of leaked internal Chinese documents that provide an unprecedented inside look at the crackdown on ethnic minorities in the Xinjiang region. This type of journalism is core to our mission to seek the truth and help people understand the world." Senator Mitch McConnell, Republican of Kentucky, spoke on the floor of the Senate on Monday about the threat to Muslim ethnic minority groups in the Xinjiang region of northwest China, pointing to the Times report.

Mr. McConnell, the Senate majority leader, said the documents were "a handbook for this Orwellian campaign to effectively erase a religious and ethnic minority in a region that is supposed to be legally distinct from the rest of China." He added the campaign was "chilling" and "systematic." Senator Chuck Schumer, Democrat of New York and the minority leader, wrote in a twitter message that "the documents obtained by the @NYTimes show top officials in the Chinese Communist Party directed a brutal & repressive campaign against the Uighurs and religious minorities. While this should surprise no one, it exposes the Chinese Communist Party's lies."

The documents, provided by a member of the political establishment in China who is concerned about the crackdown, showed the direct involvement of senior officials in conceiving and ordering it. The papers included internal speeches by China's leader, Xi Jinping, that laid the philosophical groundwork for the policy. Mr. Geng, the foreign ministry spokesman, was asked about the article at a regularly scheduled briefing.

"It is precisely because of a series of preventive counterterrorism and de-extremism measures taken in a timely manner that Xinjiang, which had been deeply plagued by terrorism, has not had a violent terrorist incident for three years," he said. The Communist government once flatly dismissed reports on the mass detentions of as many as one million Muslims as fabrications, but since evidence of the camps has become irrefutable, it has stepped up attempts to defend its actions as justifiable steps to stamp out a national security threat.

Xinjiang has experienced violent attacks, but their extent remains unclear, in part because the authorities censored reports on them at the time and continues to restrict independent reporting. After The Times published its report, China's state media tried to rebuff criticism from ethnic Uighurs in the United States, whose criticism has been highlighted by Secretary of State Mike Pompeo. The Global Times, a newspaper owned by the Communist Party, reported that its own reporters had visited the relatives of those Mr. Pompeo cited and found them living happily in Xinjiang.

"They are ashamed of the scum among their families," the report said, referring to the Uighurs now living abroad. The Chinese efforts have not tempered

international criticism. A group of 12 United Nations human rights experts has presented the Chinese government with a scathing critique of its counterterrorism laws and de-radicalization regulations, warning that they flout binding obligations under international law and risk stoking the extremism they are said to be intended to prevent. In a 21-page letter addressed to Foreign Minister Wang Yi, the experts said that laws and regulations that provide the legal framework for China's mass incarceration of Uighurs and other Muslims are "neither necessary nor proportionate." While cognizant of the security situation that China may face," they said, "we are deeply concerned that the approaches taken in the counterterrorism law not only violate fundamental rights but also may contribute to further radicalization of persons belonging to the targeted minorities, creating major and growing pockets of fear, resentment and alienation."

The letter added that "multiple laws, decrees and policies, in particular those concerning national security and terrorism, deeply erode the foundations for the viable social, economic and political development of society as a whole."

The chilling details contained in the documents obtained by The Times — such as Mr. Xi's description of Islamist radicalism as a virus or a drug addiction that required "a period of painful, interventionary treatment" — prompted new condemnations from Western politicians.

Australia's foreign minister, Marise Payne, called the disclosures disturbing, as did several American politicians, including Senator Marco Rubio, a Florida Republican, and Elizabeth Warren and Pete Buttigieg, two leading candidates in the Democratic presidential race. Former Vice President Joseph R. Biden Jr. said the treatment of the Uighurs was "among the worst abuses of human rights in the world today."

Given the sensitive nature of the subject — and the source — China's state media made little other mention of the issue. The Times's website is blocked in China, but there were signs that the disclosures had filtered through the country's so-called Great Firewall, as they received unexpected expressions of support.

One user on Weibo, one of China's most prominent social media platforms, singled out an official cited in the documents, Wang Yongzhi, who had been assigned to oversee the city of Yarkand, a cultural capital of the Uighurs. Mr. Wang, part of the Han ethnic majority in China, initially put in place many harsh measures, but became increasingly concerned about their effectiveness. When he quietly ordered the release of more than 7,000 camp inmates, he was arrested.

"History will not forget this person and this page of paper," wrote the user, identifying himself as Still Your Old Yang. Others expressed support for the official who leaked the documents. But Mr. Geng, the Foreign Ministry spokesman, said that Xinjiang had become a model for counterterrorism efforts. "The New York Times not only shut its eves and ears to the above-mentioned facts," he said, "but even use the clumsy tricks of grafting flowers and twigs to taking out of context and hyping the so-called internal documents to smear and discredit China's antiterrorism and de-extremism capabilities in Xinjiang

How far would you travel for free college?

Germany, Norway, and Iceland offer tuition-free degrees - even to American students - and the education is worldclass. Some of the universities are among the top 100 global schools.

Studying permanently abroad in those countries means fewer burdensome college loans after graduation, potentially saving you tens of thousands of dollars. The average cost of tuition and fees in the U.S. is \$36,880 per year at private colleges and \$10,440 at public universities, according to College Board.

"It's actually very surprising not just for American students but also for others that you can study at the world's leading universities essentially for free," said Gerrit Blöss, CEO of Study.eu, a portal for international students in Europe.

You don't have to speak the local language, either, so there's no need to sign up for intense foreign- language courses. Speaking English is enough.

"The number of English-taught programs in Europe has been increasing rapidly over the past years," said Carmen Neghina, a marketing analyst at Studyportals, an information portal for international students in Europe. "What started as a trend for graduate programs is now also expanding at the undergraduate level." Here's a list of high-ranking foreign universities that are tuition-free. Germany

The Technical University of Munich University of Heidelberg

The Free University of Berlin The largest national economy in Europe is

also known for public universities offering tuition-free degrees for international students. And one of these schools ranks among the top 50 worldwide.

What's more, not all degrees are taught in German. There are over 1,000 programs in English, according to Blöss. Many are for graduate students, but there's a significant offering for undergrads as well.

You only pay a fee of \$100 to \$400 to support the student government and student clubs, but, in return, you receive a local transportation ticket for the entire semester.

The application deadline for German universities is around July 15. Keep in mind that there's stiff competition, Blöss said, and German universities get to pick the best candidates

Norway University of Oslo University of Bergen Norwegian University of Science and

Welcome to Norway, home to glaciers, coastal fjords, Vikings and free tuition at its public universities regardless of your country of origin.

Don't speak Norwegian? Ikke bekymre deg - or don't worry. The majority of these

universities offer courses in English. Norwegians also are the third-best non-native English speakers in the world, so most people you meet will understand you.

But watch out: Living costs in Norway are higher than other European countries. Rent can range between \$1,100 and \$2,000 a month, Neghina said. There's also a small mandatory tax that students in Norway must pay each semester. Less

than \$100, it entitles students to sit for exams and finish for the semester. But it also gives discounts for public transportation, museums, cultural events, and access to sports facilities, Neghina said.

Iceland University of Iceland University of Akureyri Holar University College Another Nordic nation that makes the tuition-free list is Iceland. The island is home to 360,000 people and happens to be a popular school destination for Americans — it's much closer to the states compared with the rest, Blöss said. Iceland's public universities don't have tuition, but there is an annual registration or administration fee of around \$600, which all students pay.

also home to many high-ranking universities that cost less than \$5,000 a year. Austria: about \$1,700/year France: about \$3,100 to \$4,200/year Greece: about \$1,700/year Hungary: about \$1,700/year Poland: about \$2,200/ year Austria, the fifth-most popular destination for U.S. students, is home to the University of Vienna, which is among the top 150 colleges worldwide.

Until recently, France also had a tuitionfree system for international students. But the tuition fees the country implemented remain affordable compared with U.S. options, according to experts. France also offers more scholarships to international students than it did in the past.

Gay Saudi journalists detained in Australia after asylum bid

Two gay Saudi journalists who sought asylum in Australia after being threatened at home over their relationship have been held for weeks at an immigration detention centre, their lawyer said Wednesday.

The couple arrived in Australia in mid-October on tourist visas but was singled out by airport customs officials -- then taken into detention -- when they admitted plans to seek asylum, lawyer Alison Battisson told AFP.

"Australia being very well known for being... a safe place for LGBTI people, they were incredibly surprised and distressed," she said. One of the men -- who worked for Saudi Arabia's media ministry and regularly assisted visiting international news organisations -- said they came under pressure from authorities after a dissident leaked sensitive documents to foreign media.

"I was called into a prison on the outskirts of Riyadh by the state security," he told ABC, adding they "hinted that they realised I was in a relationship with my partner and that I should stop working with the foreign media".

Battisson said the men had not leaked any documents, but were swept up in a wider crackdown by Saudi authorities in the wake of Khashoggi's murder. In August, one of the men received a phone call from a relative warning they knew of their gay relationship and if it it wasn't ended his partner would be killed.

Police followed that up with separate calls asking them to come in for questioning, which led to their decision to flee.

Homosexuality is illegal in Saudi Arabia and punishable by death.

Battisson says the two men have been separated in detention as one is receiving medical treatment, while the other is housed with convicted criminals awaiting deportation. She said poor conditions in the centre and the uncertainty surrounding their case have proved "psychologically very difficult".

"Them speaking up is actually their right -- there's no reason we should remain silent about human rights abuses in Australia," she said.

The home affairs department, which oversees immigration matters, and the Australian Border Force did not respond to requests for comment.

Saudi king touts reforms, Aramco IPO in annual address

RIYADH, Saudi Arabia (AP) — Saudi King Salman touted his country's reforms in his annual address Wednesday and stressed the importance of his government's decision to publicly list shares of the state-run oil giant Aramco. He also used his speech to warn rival Iran against further aggressions.

Two key Saudi Aramco processing sites were targeted by drones and missiles in September, knocking out nearly 6% of daily global crude production. The attack was claimed by Iranian-backed Houthi rebels at war with Saudi Arabia in Yemen. The U.S. and Saudi Arabia, however, blame Iran for the attack — an allegation denied by Iran.

King Salman said Saudi Arabia's ability to quickly recover and meet global oil demand after the attacks prove "its leading role in ensuring the security and stability of global energy supplies."

Saudi Aramco is the kingdom's oil and gas producer, pumping more than 10 million barrels of crude oil a day, or some 10% of global demand.

The kingdom plans to sell 1.5% of the company on the local exchange next month, but the success of this offering is heavily dependent on the contribution of local Saudi investors and funds. The king's son and heir, Crown Prince Mohammed bin Salman, has touted the IPO as a way to create new streams of revenue for large scale projects that can create thousands of jobs for young Saudis.

Saudi Arabia is looking to raise as much as \$25.6 billion from the sale, potentially becoming the most-valuable initial public offering in history.

King Salman reiterated in his speech Saudi allegations that Iran was behind the attack on Aramco, as well as others targeting oil tankers around the Persian Gulf over the summer.

He said Saudi Arabia "adhered to wisdom in confronting these cowardly acts."

"Iran must realize that it has before it

serious choices and that for each there are consequences to bear," King Salman said, adding that his country does not seek war but is prepared to defend itself firmly against any aggression.

On Yemen, where Saudi Arabia has been at war for nearly five years, King Salman ex-

pressed hope that a recent power-sharing agreement reached in the south of the country "will open the door to broader peace talks."

Separately, the monarch also commended his government's decision to expand tourist visas this year, describing the move as a way to attract investments, create jobs and showcase Saudi heritage and culture. Previously, visit visas were largely restricted to religious pilgrims, direct relatives of



residents or small authorized tour groups.

The monarch's 8-minute-long speech was broadcast on Saudi state TV and delivered before the consultative Shura Council, senior clerics, ministers and princes. Batrawy reported from Dubai, United Arab Emirates. ABDULLAH AL-SHIHRI and AYA

Racist trolls targeted a Somali refugee's campaign. She still managed to pull off a historic victory.

With just a week to go before the election, Safiya Khalid was in tears. She had spent the past six months knocking on hundreds of doors in Lewiston, Maine, the city where she arrived as a refugee more than a decade earlier, and where she hoped to be the first Somali American to win a seat on the city council. Suddenly, online trolls from as far away as Alabama and Mississippi were hurling vile abuse at her, telling her that Muslims had no place in American government and she should go back to where she came from.

"I just couldn't take it," Khalid told The Washington Post on Tuesday night. "I was crying so bad. My eyes were completely red."

Khalid, a Democrat, was unsettled by the fact that someone had posted her address on social media. But she was also worried the hate-fueled attacks would become a distraction. So she deleted her Facebook account, asked friends to look out for worrisome comments and went back to pounding the streets with her leaflets and her clipboard.

she won her race by a significant margin. The victory, she told supporters, showed "community organizers beat Internet trolls."

At 23, Khalid may be the youngest person to ever serve on the Lewiston City Council, as well as the first Somali immigrant. She became an American citizen when she was 14. Her win on Tuesday night was one of several historic firsts across the country in local elections. In Virginia, Muslim women were elected to the state senate and the Fairfax County School Board for the first time. Nadia Mohamad, 23, became the first Muslim woman and first Somali elected to the city council in St. Louis Park, Minn., while Chol Majok, a 34-yearold who fled violence in South Sudan, became the first refugee elected to public office in Syracuse, N.Y.

But as Khalid's experience demonstrates, running for office can be complicated when you're a minority several times over. Though only about 36,000 people live in Lewiston, her campaign drew unwanted national attention as a photo from her high school days was shared thousands of times, and white nationalist blogs invoked fearmongering claims about the first two Muslim women in Congress, Rep. Ilhan Omar (D-Minn.) and Rep. Rashida Tlaib (D-Mich.). Every aspect of Khalid's identity was weaponized, she told The Post, and she was attacked for being black, Muslim, a woman and a refugee. At times, she admits, "I honestly thought, 'What did I get myself into?"

Khalid is used to facing challenges. She fled war-torn Somalia with her mother and two younger brothers at the age of 7, arriving in an unfamiliar land where they didn't speak the language and knew no one. In an interview with the Bangor Daily News, Khalid recalled that a social worker who helped her family to resettle in New Jersey filled their refrigerator with pork products, not realizing that the food was off-limits for Muslims.

Before long, Khalid's mother decided to move the family to Maine. Somali refugees had started migrating to Lewiston, a former mill town, in the early 2000s, drawn by the abundance of cheap housing, good schools and low crime rate. Today, Khalid says, roughly a third of the city's population is Somali.

Khalid embraced her new home, working for the area's best-known employer, L.L. Bean, as she made her way through Lewiston High and the University of Southern Maine. While still in college, she unsuccessfully ran for a seat on the school board. Her desire to hold public office, she told The Post on Tuesday, came from watching city leadership remain stubbornly white as the city grew increasingly diverse. So when a seat on the Lewiston City Council opened up earlier this year, Khalid didn't have to think hard about entering the race. She was tired of hearing anti-immigrant rhetoric from President Trump and former Maine governor Paul LePage, a Lewiston native who once claimed that asylum seekers brought diseases and were the biggest problem facing the state.

"Minority people were being attacked and felt invisible, because they did not feel represented in positions of power," she said.

After finishing up at her day job as a youth mentor at a nonprofit that helps immigrants, Khalid would hit the streets for hours of door-knocking before it grew dark. Her campaign focused on pragmatic issues like building more affordable housing and addressing lead contamination, though she frequently spoke of the need for a "fresh perspective" in city government. Some saw that as an attack on older, wealthier white people, she said on Tuesday, but that wasn't how she meant it.

"Any local government needs to be reflective of the community," she said.

It was only in the campaign's final stretch that things turned ugly. During the last week of

October, videos appeared on YouTube, showing what Khalid's opponent claimed was an attempt at intimidation and harassment. They had been filmed in August, shortly after Walter "Ed" Hill decided to join the race, and appeared to show people ringing his doorbell and knocking on his door, then calling him "cowardly" and "pathetic" when he didn't answer.

Hill, also a Democrat, told local news outlets that the culprits were members of the Lewiston Democratic Committee, who were angered by his decision to run against Khalid and showed up to demand an explanation. Because he was recovering from surgery and on painkillers, he had been unable to get up and answer the door, he said, telling the Bangor Daily News that he felt "scared and pretty vulnerable." Khalid's campaign has repeatedly condemned the incident and said it had nothing to do with it. But, as Mainer reported, the story soon spread to local right-wing Facebook groups. Commenters began mocking Khalid's hijab and suggesting people in Lewiston should send her back to Somalia because "we are slowly losing our city."

Before long, trolls with no apparent connection to Maine were falsely claiming Khalid wanted to institute sharia law in Lewiston and spamming her campaign's Facebook page with racist comments and outright threats. Many, the Sun Journal wrote, were "too graphic and inappropriate to be published."

Campaign volunteers went into overdrive trying to delete and report the worst of the attacks, but the harassment didn't stop. Trolls got hold of a photo taken when Khalid was a 15-year-old high school student, which showed her making a goofy face and giving the finger to the camera, and plastered it across social media.

ning for a position in a governmental role for the town of Lewiston, Maine," said one tweet that was shared nearly 4,000 times in the lead-up to the election. "Make her go viral."

Even though she knew it would make campaigning harder, Khalid temporarily deleted her personal Facebook account "for my own sanity," she told The Post. It was crunchtime for the election, so she didn't report the threatening messages and harassment to the police, even though she started to get nervous when someone from a neighboring town posted her address on Facebook.

"I probably should have taken that step," she said on Tuesday, "but with the election in a few days, I felt like all my energy needed to be at the door with voters."

When results came in on Tuesday, Khalid learned she had defeated Hill with nearly 70 percent of the vote. The decisive win showed that Lewiston residents didn't see eye-to-eye with the online trolls and had a different vision of the city's future, her campaign manager, Jacob Nishimura, told The Post. "I still feel numb," Khalid told The Post later that night. "It's still unbelievable that it actually happened. Watching a high school photo used to argue that she was unfit for office cemented Khalid's belief that young women who enter politics are subject to extra scrutiny. But knocking on more than 1,000 doors and giving up her nights and weekends to the campaign taught her another lesson.

Over and over again, she said, people told her they would be voting for her because she had gone to the trouble of showing up. The race was won door by door, she said, "not on the Internet.

I want to go there, to their graves. I want to pray," said Hussain, in a speech dated November 9. I am a peace-loving person. I will not interfere in any politics, I promise. But just give me, along with my colleagues, a place to live in India and I request you to grant some Baloch, Sindhis whose name I give, asylum as well," he said.

In his plea to India, the MQM leader said his house and offices have been seized leaving him with no means to "fight for justice" against the Pakistani regime https://in.news.yahoo.com/

22 Surprising Facts About The Early Humans

Early Humans Left Africa

Over 1 Million Years Ago Homo sapiens, the ancestors of modern man, originated in Africa. The "Out of Africa" theory suggests that our ancestors left the continent and migrated to Europe and Asia. In doing so, they began replacing earlier examples of the human species - the Homo Erectus.

This migration took place approximately 80,000 years ago. What is interesting to note is that the Homo erectus (upright human) had actually followed the exact same route (from Africa to Eurasia) - over 1 million years ago. Looks like Homo sapiens weren't the first to get this idea. Homo sapiens has only had a cul-

ture for less than 50,000 years Many anthropologists now believe that early humans probably did not develop a culture until around that time. When we consider that the "mitochondrial Eve" theory suggests that we are all descended from one East African woman who lived about 200-150,000 years ago, It is shocking.

Homo sapiens evolved over 150,000 years ago, around the time of mitochondrial Eve - the most recent common maternal ancestor of people currently on Earth. This means our species hung around for a really long time before we developed art, symbolic communication, ornaments, and bone tools. Pre-cultural humans did have sophisticated toolkits and fire, but anthropologists believe that they didn't invent language until a cultural explosion. Early Humans have incredibly low

genetic diversity Humans are among the least genetically diverse species mostly because we prob-

diverse species, mostly because we probably descended from a small group of early humans who lived in East Africa. Population geneticists describe genetic diversity with a measure called "effective population size." Basically, effective population size is how many people you would need to reproduce the genetic diversity of our full population. For humans, this number is really low and hovers around 15,000 individuals. It is kind of crazy when you consider that actual population size is 7 billion. If compared to mice, some species of them have an effective population size of 733,000

The Human Population Decreased 80,000 Years Ago

About 80,000 years ago there was a drastic reduction in the size of the human population. Archeologists are still not 100% sure what caused the decline, but it definitely wasn't pretty. Some say there may have been a massive volcanic eruption that filled the sky with millions of particles of ash, blocking the sun's heat for many years and in so doing created freezing temperatures that would have severely affected life and population growth on earth at the time

Our Ancestors Were More Developed Than You Expect

During this time our ancestors were smallbrained apemen that many assumed survived off what they could find: food that the land produced or the meat that came from animals that had already died from natural causes or had been left behind by other larger predators. But the discovery of hunting and eating tools suggest our ancestors maybe have been more intellectually developed than originally thought. Fire

As we know, there are a few things that set us apart from our animal counterparts - these include walking on two legs, creating and using stone tools, and being able to manage the natural element of fire. Evidence of fire being used as a tool came from archaeologists' discovery of Stone Age flint tools, which were used to both create fire and for scraping and cutting meat.

We May Have Neanderthal Genes Neanderthals are our closest extinct human relatives. Our well-known, but often misunderstood ancestors lived in Europe and Asia as early as 200,000 years ago until about 30,000 years ago. While the Neanderthals' appearance was slightly similar to ours, they were shorter and stockier with angled cheekbones, prominent brow ridges, and wide noses. These qualities were important for survival in Europe's cold climate and in order to hunt big animals for food. Though sometimes thought of as barbarians, scientists have discovered that Neanderthals in fact used tools, buried their dead and had control over fire. Homo Sapiens Always Evolve Human evolution is the extended process of change that suggests humans originated from apelike ancestors. Scientific evidence shows that the physical and behavioral traits shared by all people stemmed from these ancestors and evolved over an extended period of time. Our species, as suggested by many, will continue to evolve in response to our living conditions - different food, geographical and environmental changes, the advent of modern technology and of course the amalgamation of our different races.

Different Types Of Food Allowed Us To Evolve

One of the primary factors of evolution is the food we consume. In the past, after travelling far distances and adapting to new locations, our ancestor's diet changed according to what food was available to them. Their diet initially consisted of nuts, seeds, fish, insects and small animals - providing the foundation that helped evolve our brain, and develop our intelligence. This resulted in early human's creating advanced tools and using fire, which helped the evolution train keep on chugging

A new study that was published in the scientific journal PNAS in 2018, claims that this diversity in the homo-sapiens diet is what allowed us to evolve over the neanderthals that consumed mainly meat. When the ice age made herds of animals fleet, the neanderthals starved while the homo-sapiens could nourish from other sources. The diet was perfected throughout the years and in the last few thousand of years, it is known as the Mediterranian diet. People who keep this diet to this day are known to live longer than others. Our Fists Have Constantly Evolved To Give A Punch Considering our faces have evolved in order to receive a punch to the face - it makes sense that the part of our body used for delivering the punch would have had to evolve as well. The notion that evolution shaped our hands, not for dexterity, but to form fists, recently emerged from a study of anatomical changes in humans. The study suggests that at about the same time we started walking upright, our hands became short and square with opposable thumbs. This change has always been recognised as a means for tool manipulation, but recent studies suggest the ability to form a fist was actually an evolutionary step to help to deliver a punch when fighting.

The Human Face Evolved To Withstand A Punch

However, a million years ago, battles and fist fights were commonplace, and research suggests the battles between humans could end up being pretty brutal. Therefore it makes sense that our faces would have evolved in order to take a punch to the face.

Clothes

While exact dates are always difficult to come by, studies have found out when our human-like ancestors began using the skin of animals to keep them warm. The need to do so may have arisen sometime after losing a large portion of body hair. Scientists estimate the time at which human began wearing "clothes" at around 1 million years ago. This time frame was decided by examining factors such as genetic skin-colouration of our ancestors at around this time.

Language Skills

There are some scientists that believe that communication traits and the use of language arose from a common dialect spoken by our ancestors when they were all still in Africa. This language may have been made up of sounds and grunts as opposed to formal words, but were certainly used as a means for instruction and expression. With over 5000 different languages spoken in the world today, this concept is highly likely. Linguists and anthropologists suggest that human language probably started to develop around 100,000 years ago.

Anthropologist Pushes Back Date of First Humans Hunting For Meat To Two Million Years Ago Evidence from an ancient butchery site in Tanzania shows that early man was capable of ambushing herds of animals up to 1.6 million years earlier than previously thought. Ancient humans used complex hunting techniques to ambush and kill antelopes, gazelles, wildebeest and other large animals at least two million years ago.

We Used to be Hobbits (Sort Of) A hobbit-like species of humans lived approximately 18,000 years ago, according to Australian and Indonesian researchers. The species lived among pygmy elephants, 10-foot lizards, and were no taller than the average 3-year-old.

Our Brains are Shrinking While may be getting smarter, our brains are getting more compact, explains University of Wisconsin researcher John Hawkes. Really, the reduction in size probably correlates with our decreased physical size. Less mass means less brain needed to control it.

Right-handed people outnumber lefties nine to one. But in competitive sports, lefthanded people are far more represented, leading many theorists to conclude that early cultures developed "handedness" as a form of cooperation.

Stone Tools The creation and use of stone tools by our ancestors is estimated at about 2.6 million years ago. In Dikika, Ethiopia, however, researchers have found fossil animal bones with possible butchery marks from up to 3.4 million years ago. 



Panipat trailer highlights the myopic portrayal of Afghani characters in recent Bollywood films, from Padmaavat to Kesari

'Aye mere pyaare watan,' the song by Manna Dey in the film Kabuliwala, picturised on Balraj Sahni looking forlorn in a land far away from his country, is among the finest and fondest renditions of the ethos of the upright noble, loyal, affectionate, emotional Pathans from Afghanistan. Over the years, given the changing geopolitical alignments, no doubt, the Afghan in Indian cinema's collective imagination has crystallised into someone very different from the virtuous one in Kabuliwala, or even the gentleman Pathan villain Sher Khan, immortalised by Pran in the film Zanjeer.

However, Bollywood's penultimate tribute to the magnanimous, masculine nobility that Pathans from Afghanistan stood for, would have to be Amitabh Bachchan's outing as the strapping hero Badhshah Khan in Khuda Gawah.

From all accounts, the shooting of the film was nothing short of a momentous event. Even though the country was undergoing political turmoil in the wake of the vacuum left behind by Russian troops, the film crew had no trouble filming. Big B in a blog had even shared details of how the red carpet was rolled out for them with the local administration and how people went to great lengths to make their stay pleasant and memorable.

If anything, the incident highlighted the fact that Afghans have been ardent fans of Hindi movies.

In fact, I witnessed the Indo-Afghan warmth first-hand in Delhi when I attended Express Adda — a live fireside chat with a celebrity, organised by The Indian Express where Amitabh Bachchan was the Chief Guest for the evening. An Afghan gentleman from the audience got up and for many minutes, recounted his memory of Bachchan's visit to his country. Bachchan, ever avuncular, chatted with the gentleman at length sharing his own fond memories. The warmth in this cordial exchange of anecdotes was unmistakable.

Cinema had obviously created a bridge between the two countries with different cultures and ethinicities, an emotive connect that government protocols often fail to muster.

Of late though, with the growing emphasis on the assertion of a nationalist identity, that luminous powerful bridge seems to be collapsing under the strain of acknowledging non-Hindu identities (read Muslim) as anything but unjust, unfair and villainous. It is almost as though the new villains in Hindi cinema after smugglers, drug lords and terrorists, are the invaders from the hoary past. The Pathans of new Hindi cinemas have few shades other than black. The messaging is plain to see — black is the colour of their clothes, the kohl in their eyes and the colour of the hearts that beat in their chests

The film Panipat's trailer just dropped on the world-wide-web and the one notable and striking part of the trailer was Ahmed Shah Abdali being essayed by Sanjay Dutt on-screen. The film, a period drama based on the third battle of Panipat, had the striking visual of Dutt kitted out in threatening black as he marches towards a much smaller army headed by Sadashiv Rao Bhau (Arjun Kapoor), a Maratha general sporting pristine white.

Dutt, as Abdali, looks every inch the villain, complete with gnashing teeth and a devious attitude, a continuum of the single-note character we saw as Alauddin Khilji in the film Padmaavat, who was attributed every shade of debauched villainy, or the Machiavellian Pathans in the film Kesari.

That according to history, Abdali slaughtered thousands of warriors and defeated the Maratha forces, is likely to be picturised in myriad ways to reinforce the dastardly machinations of the Invader. According to history, the Marathas were routed in the battle. Showcasing a defeat in a film can only be meaningful if the victor is shown as conniving and evil, one

not deserving of the victory. Only this manipulated villainy can ensure that the hero emerges with his halo intact even in a defeat. Panipat: The Great Betrayal in all probability aligns with this cinematic wisdom.

Large-scale Indian Cinema, the commercial kind, unfortunately rides purely on the sensational simplification, not on nuance. Despite Bollywood's attempt at being "woke" and nuanced, binaries are still profoundly missing in our characters. To circle back to the earlier examples—in Kabuliwala, Abdul Rehman Khan is accused of murder (it is never proven) but he is also shown as a gentle soul yearning for his daughter in a foreign land. Sher Khan of Zanjeer is a powerful outlaw who mends his ways. But these are examples from the past. In present times, Hindi cinema seems to find just one slot for Pathan characters—villains from history.

But the malaise is not just in Bollywood. Hollywood for instance has often been accused of being largely patriarchal, and putting the white male at the center of all proceedings. The non-normative issues and relationships being side-lined even in Hollywood films is common. For long after 9/11 the only Afghan one would see in a Hollywood film would be a fanatic or a terrorist. Although, with greater consciousness and sensitivity some of that has begun to change. Popular shows on television and films are now breaking some of the ethnicity and religious barriers as well as stereotypes of how Muslims, and people of colour are depicted.

Given its recent creative twist, the big question that now looms ahead is whether Bollywood cinema will continue to have its passionate fans across Afghan borders. According to news reports online, the Afghan embassy in India has already expressed concerns over Abdali's portrayal in the film suggesting an expectation of one of their illustrious rulers not being painted a heartless villain.

It would be interesting to observe whether Panipat: The Great Betrayal serves to codify Pathans as the convenient bad guys with no redeeming virtue in period dramas or not.

Or, will Bollywoodwalas do some introspection and bring back the Kabuliwalas






