


RE	MUSIC	PE	HISTORY/GEOGRAPHY

<p>We will be continuing with Read Write Inc to support children in learning letters and sounds. This knowledge will then be extended upon to develop writing and reading skills.</p> <p>We will look closely at the differences between Fiction and Non-Fiction texts and use these to support our own writing. Information books on pigs, buildings and The Tower of London will be a key focus. We will look closely at the success criteria for writing a recount, set of instructions and a report.</p>			<p>This half term we will explore a variety of media, particularly when creating 3D projects. We will work with clay to produce our own pig from the story and develop collage techniques to create vivid Tower images.</p>	<p>As our school is rapidly expanding we have decided to add our own 'wing'. The children will use their 'architect' skills to design and build a new room. They will draw upon their skills of forming, connecting together and construction, along with knowledge of properties of materials.</p>
