## READY TO LEARN

Ages and Stages Questionnaire
On Track Scores vary depending on the age of the child and the survey area. A child is considered "ontrack" if he or she scores in the Typical range. Alternatively, a child may score in the Monitor or Refer ranges where additional services are available to support the development of the child.
