The scholarship amount is \$500.00.

The scholarship is open to seniors who have been accepted to a college or university.

Each applicant MUST submit the following to be considered:

*Completed application - 3 Pages (attached to this document)

*400-500 word typed essay

*A sealed copy of your high school transcript

Answer EACH question with complete sentences and correct grammar and punctuation marks. Answers to these questions will develop your essay.

1. Who was Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr.?
2. When did Dr. King's birthday become a national holiday?
3. Which weekend is the MLK Celebration held in Elberton each year?
4. How many events are held each year during the MLK Celebration? What are they?
5. Have you ever participated in the MLK weekend of activities? If yes, what did you do? If you haven't, would you like to? Why?
6. Why should you be considered for this scholarship?

Essays will be judged on content, grammar and whether you have answered questions accurately. Your work should be typed, double spaced, 400-500 words, and size 14 font. Each answered question should be a 5 sentence or more paragraph. Meaning, you should have at least 5 paragraphs or more (400-500 words) once your essay is finished.

***All applicants must have a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or higher.**
