CAM CornerAnnual Meeting

Congratulations to all the owners for the successful annual meeting of the members held in March. The three proxy questions all passed; should the association over-stripe the two remaining tennis courts for pickle ball? Should the association roll over excess funds if any into budget year 2018 to avoid adverse income tax consequences? Weather Bug Lightning System



As most owners are aware, southwest Florida has the dubious distinction of being one of the lightening capitols of the world. Lightening is one of the most studied weather phenomenon. Following some local headlining unfortunate deaths at beaches and on high school practice fields, a lot of emphasis was placed on technology of detection and early warning. Municipalities started purchasing the

systems, then came golf courses and practice fields, and now community associations. The picture to the left is the newest addition to the life / safety technology that the board of directors have invested in. This particular model is the Weather Bug lightening early warning system. It

will detect the presence of lightening within a tenmile radius and set off a visual and audible alarm which will close the pools immediately upon sounding. The audible alarm could be likened to a truck horn, it goes off for approximately 5 seconds, simultaneously a strobe flashes and remains flashing while danger is detected. Once the danger has passed, the horn sounds three short blasts and the flashing light shuts off.

Another benefit of the Weather Bug system is the ability of owners to monitor if the pools are open or closed from their smart phone. We have an app that is tied directly to our pools in real time that alerts owners of the pool status.

More Technology - More Antennas

High atop the clubhouse and the rec center are antennas that will be sending the wifi signal from the clubhouse to the rec center. This will eliminate a large portion of the telecommunications bill each month. Last year we physically wired the buildings together to monitor the cameras at the rec center pool in the clubhouse. Wiring is not suitable for the wifi signal since the losses through the wire reduce the bandwidth of the wifi significantly. We expect to have the two buildings communicating by mid-May, a VOIP phone system will replace the landline for the alarms and the 911 phone service. Eventually, the office will be using VOIP phones as well reducing our telecommunications bill to a fraction of what it was.






