

Tombstone Rules

At the first Tee.....there is a blue bin with wooden crosses!

Use a jiffy marker and print your first initial and last name on the cross.

Also... put your handicap 'added to the course par', as per below:

Example: Our Course par is 70, plus your handicap 22 = 92.

Write that number beside your name

- Carry your tombstone with you.
- When you run out of strokes, (handicap plus 70 par rating) you stick your tombstone in the ground.
 - In otherwords you have to shoot one less than your handicap and par rating combined.
- Where your last shot comes to rest, that is where you are buried! Place your cross in the ground at that point. (If your shot ends on a green, place your cross just off the fringe).
- All players that haven't died by the end of the 18th hole will return to the clubhouse with their cross.
- All putts must be holed out. No gimmies. Each stroke is important. It is another nail in your coffin!
- After you have died, you can still complete your round.
