Snohomish County USBC Women's Only Tournament Rules

1. Participation in this USBC certified tournament is limited to female members of the Snohomish County USBC. Bowlers living within the jurisdiction of the SCUSBC who are non-members of another association may participate in this tournament with the purchase of an affiliate USBC membership card for \$10.00.
2. Entry fee is \$25 per bowler, as follows: Prize Fund \$14.00, Bowling Fee \$9.00 and tournament expense fee \$2.00. The prize fund will be returned 100% in all of the events, paying 1 in 5.
3. All bowlers are reminded that this tournament CLOSES at MIDNIGHT on February 28, 2020.
4. This is a one-division handicapped tournament, calculated at 90% of 220. **The bowler is required to submit the previous season's highest average of: A) A single USBC league average based on a minimum of 21 games if you only bowled 1 league.** Bowlers without such a yearbook average may bowl using their highest 2019 Summer League certified average of 21 or more games. Bowlers without a certified 2018-2019 yearbook average or 2019 summer league average may bowl using their current season highest 21-or-more game average as of January 1, 2020. Per USBC Rule 319a2, if a bowler's current average is 10 pins or more higher for 21 games than their prior season's yearbook average, the current average with 21 more games as of January 1, 2020 must be used. All other bowlers will bowl scratch (220).
5. Bowlers are responsible for verifying their own average, whether submitted by the bowler, the team captain or others. See USBC Rule 319a3. Failure to use the correct average shall disqualify score if submitted average is lower than actual average, thereby resulting in more handicaps. Prize winnings shall be based on the submitted average if it is higher than the correct average. However, corrections in averages may be permitted up to the completion of the first game of a series. Failure to make proper corrections shall disqualify score.
6. The average adjustment and reporting requirements of USBC Rule 319c, 319d and 319e shall apply to all entrants. Disqualified teams or individuals shall forfeit all money and awards.
7. THE ENTIRE ENTRY FEE MUST BE PAID WHEN ENTRY IS SUBMITTED, BEFORE THE CLOSING DEADLINE. Forfeited money will be added to the prize fund. No entry fees will be refunded unless entry is disqualified before bowling.
8. A \$35.00 fee will be charged for ALL Returned checks.
9. All first-place ties will be declared co-champions. First and second place prize money will be added together and divided equally.
10. A maximum of One PWBA members will be allowed per team. PWBA members who are no longer paying members will have a three-year waiting period before being reclassified.
11. Entries (including payment of all entry fees) close at MIDNIGHT on Wednesday February 28, 2020.
12. There must be at least 10 teams for the added money to be added.
