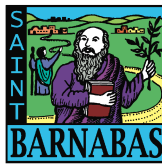

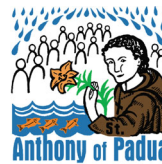

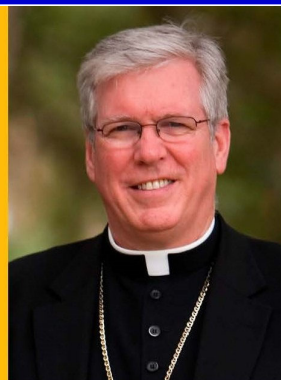

The Diocese of Venice continues to promote *Share the Journey*, a worldwide two-year initiative of Our Holy Father, Pope Francis. The Diocese will continue to run a series designed to answer questions focusing more specifically on Refugee Resettlement. This will serve as an aide to build bridges of reconciliation, understanding and hospitality, in keeping with the spirit of *Share the Journey*. The topics covered include: "What Does the Gospel Say About Refugees?", "What is the Economic Impact?" and "Are Refugees a Burden?", etc. Below is the fourth topic of the series.

What is the Economic Impact?

1. While refugees here five years or less have a median household income of \$22,000, that figure more than triples in the following decades, growing far faster than other foreign-born groups. By the time a refugee has been in the U.S. at least 25 years, their median household income reaches \$67,000—a full \$14,000 more than the median U.S. income. *New Economy*

2. Refugees find work in the U.S. far earlier than in other countries and start businesses at an even quicker pace than the American-born. Google co-founder Sergey Brin came to America as a refugee. The father of Steve Jobs, CEO of Apple, was a Syrian refugee. *Sources: University of Notre Dame, MPI, Center for American Progress, Notable Names Database*

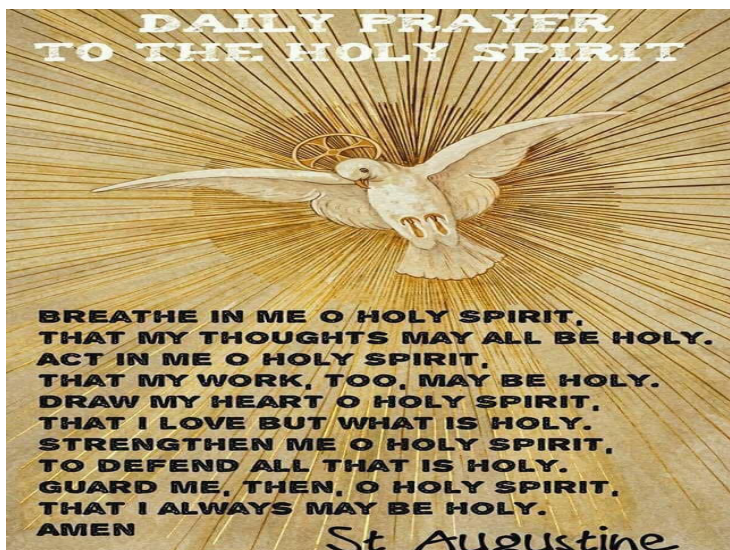
VIVIENDO PROFETICAMENTE

Los corintios sabían lo que era experimentar sufrimiento y angustia, mucho de lo cual ellos mismos se causaban. Su comunidad cristiana, fundada no veinte años después de la muerte de Jesús, enfrentaron comportamientos escandalosos y desacuerdos desgarradores. Para animarlos, san Pablo escribió que la “momentánea luz de mortificación produce

para nosotros un peso eterno de gloria más allá de toda comparación”. San Pablo no niega el sufrimiento de ellos. Él no pretende que el ser cristiano es algo fácil. Al contrario, él invita a los corintios a aceptar sus dificultades y ponerlas en perspectiva: la carga más pesada en la tierra no pesa nada comparada con la poderosa Gloria preparada por Dios para nosotros en el cielo. Viviendo con esta perspectiva nos hace profetas. Un profeta habla de la verdad de Dios al mundo, e indica al Pueblo de Dios que regresen al Señor. Cuando vivimos en la esperanza profética, creyendo en la gloria eterna de Dios, recordamos al mundo los planes poderosos y misericordiosos de Dios para la humanidad. Al igual que san Pablo, podemos animar a otras personas a enfrentar el sufrimiento valientemente y a no cansarse de hacer la voluntad de Dios. Jesús promete que, si hacemos la voluntad de Dios, somos “sus hermanos, hermanas y madre”. Somos su familia. Y él siempre protege a su familia.

It also promises, however, that we can persevere if we but recognize that Christ is within us, renewing us daily, and giving us the courage and the strength we need to endure. The Gospel promises that doing God's will makes us "family" with Jesus, who forgives all sin and triumphs over evil.

Today might be a good day for us to make some promises as well. We can promise to stop kidding ourselves about our own tendencies to selfishness and sin. We can promise ourselves to believe—really believe—that while we are not sinless, we are forgiven. 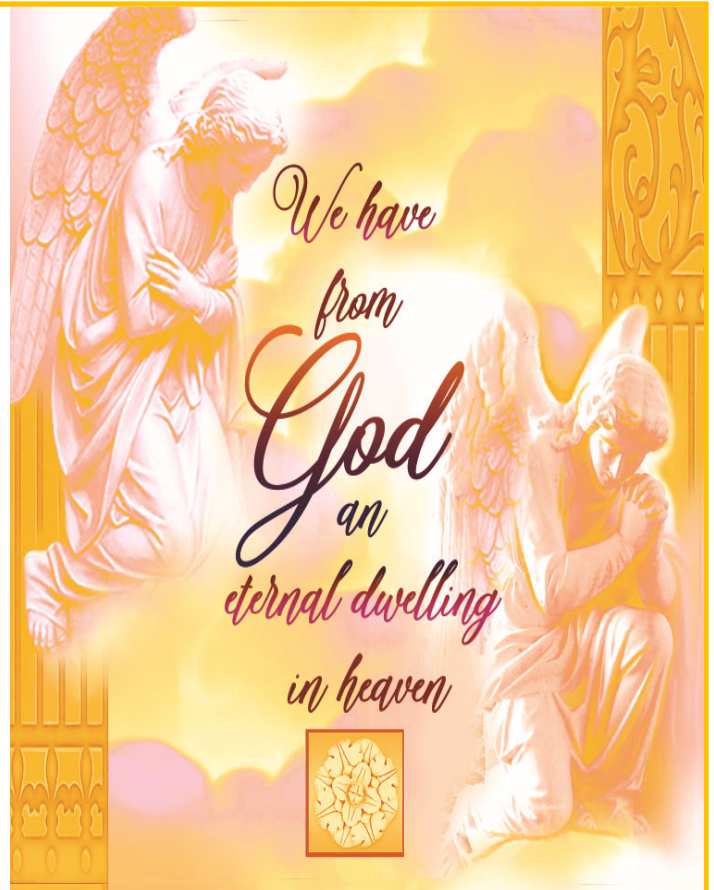

TREASURES FROM OUR TRADITION

The cathedral is a treasure in a diocese and in our tradition. It is not simply a "big church," as some say; some parish churches are larger. What makes a cathedral is the presence of the chair, called a *cathedra* (Latin for seat) reserved for the bishop.

There are many instances in our country of a local church (diocese) outgrowing a cathedral. In Baltimore and St. Louis, the former cathedrals are historic treasures in the heart of the old city, but new and larger structures now function as the seat of the bishop.

When a bishop dies or retires, it is said that "the seat is vacant," and when the new bishop is installed, the central ritual is the moment when the decree of the Holy Father is read and the new bishop is escorted to the *cathedra*. No one but the bishop sits in the *cathedra* during a ritual, but in Los Angeles the *cathedra* in the Cathedral of Our Lady of the Angels is accessible, and no one seems to mind when a visitor tries the *cathedra* out for the bishop's point of view.—Rev. 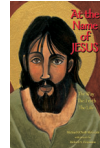

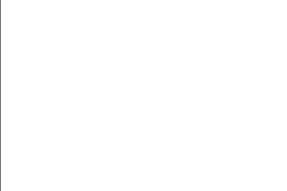
