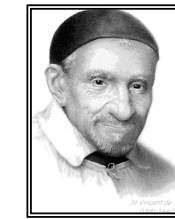

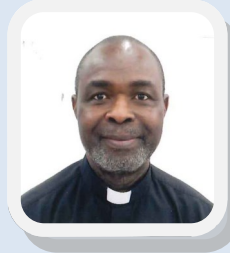

## THE CATECHISM OF THE CATHOLIC CHURCH

Baptism in the Church §1226

1226 From the very day of Pentecost the Church has celebrated and administered holy Baptism. Indeed St. Peter declares to the crowd astounded by his preaching: "Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins; and you shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit." The apostles and their collaborators offer Baptism to anyone who believed in Jesus: Jews, the God-fearing, pagans. Always, Baptism is seen as connected with faith: "Believe in the Lord Jesus, and you will be saved, you and your household," St. Paul declared to his jailer in Philippi. And the narrative continues, the jailer "was baptized at once, with all his family."

## CATECISMO DE LA IGLESIA CATOLICA

El Bautismo en la Iglesia §1226

1226 Desde el día de Pentecostés la Iglesia ha celebrado y administrado el santo Bautismo. En efecto, san Pedro declara a la multitud conmovida por su predicación: "Convertíos [...] y que cada uno de vosotros se haga bautizar en el nombre de Jesucristo, para remisión de vuestros pecados; y recibiréis el don del Espíritu Santo" (Hch 2,38). Los Apóstoles y sus colaboradores ofrecen el bautismo a quien crea en Jesús: judíos, hombres temerosos de Dios, paganos (Hch 2,41; 8,12-13; 10,48; 16,15). El Bautismo aparece siempre ligado a la fe: "Ten fe en el Señor Jesús y te salvarás tú y tu casa", declara san. Pablo a su carcelero en Filipos. El relato continúa: "el carcelero inmediatamente recibió el bautismo, él y todos los suyos" (Hch 16,31-33).

### WEEK OF PRAYER FOR CHRISTIAN UNITY

January 18-25

Every year, churches across the world mark this week to pray together for

Christian unity. The event is celebrated by millions of Christians uniting us in faith, prayer and fellowship. By this means at least once a year, Christians are reminded of Jesus' prayer for his disciples that "they may be one so that the world may believe" (see John 17.21). The Week of Prayer for Christian Unity is kept annually between 18 January and 25 January. Pope Pius X officially blessed the concept, and Benedict XV encouraged its observance throughout the entire Roman Catholic Church. The theme for The Week of Prayer for Christian Unity for 2019 is "Justice, Only Justice, You Shall Pursue" (cf. Deuteronomy 16:20). It was chosen for its powerful message of promoting truth, equality and unity.
