Go Ahead, Read a Psalm Today

We are studying Life changing Psalms on Sunday morning so I thought I would share a little more about the book of Psalms. Psalms is the longest book in the Bible (150 chapters), the Psalms are songs, and was the Hebrews

song book. Although David is credited with writing most of the psalms, other contributors include Moses, Solomon, Asaph, and the Sons of Korah. One bible student divided the book of Psalms into five sections.

- God *beside* us! (#1-41)
- God *before* us! (#42-72)
- God *around* us! (#73-89)
- God *above* us! (#90-106)
- God *among* us! (#107-150)

God's Word is sweeter than honey and more desirable than gold or silver (Psalm 19:10). *Why not begin reading the book of Psalms today and begin with a prayer like this: Heavenly Father, I want to come into your presence with singing and enter your courts with thanksgiving and praise (Psalm 100). You are my God. You are good. Blessed be your name forever and ever! In Jesus' name, amen.*

MARCH ACTIVITIES:

- Delivered items to both Hospice Homes during March and our next Hospice Ministry Sunday will be **April 7th**.
- There were a total of **336** items delivered to the Bethesda Center in WS which provides shelter for homeless men and women in WS. Your donations to this project were greatly appreciated.
- Last month I reported that Rhianna Weavil had baked 11 dozen cookies for the Hospice Ministry as part of a school service project but that only began to "touch the surface". An end result was a total of 42 ¾ dozen cookies which equals to 513 cookies. And she completed her required 20 hours service project for school. Way to go, Rhianna!!!
- The Forsyth County Jail & Prison Chaplaincy Ministry was chosen as our emphasis for the month of March and as voted and approved, \$47.74 of WOM funds were used to purchase shampoo, deodorant, soap and toothpaste for this ministry.
- On Saturday, March 16th, Marie, Carole, Beverly and Jane attended the PMBA Annual Salad Supper and were very privileged to hear Tejadi Hanchell who happens to be the chaplain for the Jail and Prison Ministry speak on behalf of the chaplaincy program. Also, one of the current inmates Miguel gave a heartwarming tribute to this ministry and how his life had been changed after coming to know Christ.
- As part of our Inward Missions, a few meals were prepared for some of our members.

Plans are being finalized for a home cooked meal for the families staying at the SECU House in WS, collecting food for the Baptist Children's Home Annual Food Roundup, additional visits to H.O.P.E (Help our People Eat) to make bagged lunches and package fresh vegetables are being scheduled and our Annual Ladies Fellowship Tea.

Every lady in our church is invited to join us for our next meeting on **Wednesday, April 3rd**. I so often hear "why so many projects & how do you all do it". Believe me, it happens because of our faith in Christ and the love and support of the members of UCBC. The reward comes from deep within hoping that maybe, just maybe, we have made a difference in someone's life. May we continue this each month as **UNION CROSS REACHES OUT TO SHOW HIS LOVE.**
