Through Renewal Ministries in Ann Arbor, Michigan, she collaborates in the young adult ministry *i.d.916* and is part of the teaching team for their annual Summer Institute School of Bible Study.

Lavinia has been a host of *Real Living* and *Unpacking the Gospel*, two weekly radio programs in Lexington, Kentucky, on relevant issues facing today's Catholics. She has led and participated in catechist and deacon formation, RCIA, adult education, and CCD. Lavinia is active in parish renewal and the Catholic Charismatic Renewal in the US and Italy.
