**Trail Report:** Most of the trail is in, waiting on a few clubs as there is crop and water issues. Trail may be slightly different than previous years due to slight moves. Whitewater trail may have issues with water, tractor was breaking through. SNARS, two clubs are turned in, tr to get this turned in ASAP so that we can get money coming in. Quadrant signs, approval was given, 28 signs ordered, once they are ready, they will be given to the appropriate clubs and Levi will let you know where to have them placed.
