Thoughts From Hatton

ONE SOURCE FOR SALVATION

Many will look to the creeds of men in order to find salvation for their souls. However, in order to receive the remission of sins, one must turn to the correct source. That source is not the Methodist Discipline or the book of Mormon. It is not the Hiscox Manual either. The correct source is the scriptures. It is by the scriptures that one may know he has eternal life (1 John 5:13). Some in the denominational world may express a degree of uncertainty with regard to salvation and if it is possessed. However, if one relies on the Bible, no doubt may remain!

If someone is willing to be honest, the Bible is the only book which is able to save a man's soul. James commanded his audience to "lay apart all filthiness and superfluity of naughtiness, and receive with meekness the engrafted word, which is able to save your souls" (Jam. 1:21).
