The following positions will be voted on at Our Reunion Meeting to be held on Saturday July 6, 2019. Also listed is job description per our by-laws.

PRESIDENT –

1: The President shall preside at all meetings of the AXP and AXP Board; preserve order and decorum therein and enforce strict observance to the Constitution and By-Laws of the AXP.

2: The President shall appoint his/her staff which shall serve only for his/her President's term of office.

3: The President shall appoint members to the Executive Committee to serve unfulfilled terms as the need arises.

4: The President shall appoint all special committees unless the rule is suspended by a majority vote of the AXP Board.

5: The President shall appoint a Chapel Fund Administrator as the requirement arises and can only be removed by a majority vote of the AXP Board.

6: The President shall, on behalf of the AXP and with the concurrence of their Board, renew the lease (with appropriate authorities) for the AXP Museum, Chapel, and surrounding grounds, approximately 9.5 acres, at 650 Elliott Drive, Xenia, Ohio, and shall ensure the AXP complies with the requirements of the lease.

7: The President may initiate, at his/her discretion, action to remove any Executive Committee member who has missed two or more consecutive meetings or three or more meetings in a year without notifying the President.

8: The President shall, at the end of each year in office, compile a record of his/ her year's work and provide such record on file in the AXP Museum (or other designated location).

1st VICE-PRESIDENT –

1: The First Vice-President shall preside in the absence of the President and shall serve as an aide to the President.

2: The First Vice-President shall be Chairperson of the Christmas Committee. His/her duties shall be to coordinate all facets of Christmas Dinner.

3: The First Vice-President shall be Chairperson of the Memorial Day Committee. His/her duties shall be to coordinate all facets of Memorial Day.

4: The First Vice-President shall be Chairperson of the Annual Reunion. His/her duties shall be to coordinate all facets of Reunion.

2nd VICE-PRESIDENT –

1: The Second Vice-President shall preside in the absence of the President and the First Vice-President. He/she shall serve as an aide to these officers.

2: The Second Vice-President shall serve as the Chairperson of the Nominating Committee at reunion

3: The Second Vice-President shall be Chairperson of the Loyalty Projects Committee. His/her duties shall be to coordinate all raffles and Sales at Christmas Dinner, Memorial Day Picnic, and Reunion.

TREASURER –

1: The Treasurer shall receive all monies due to the AXP and shall disburse all monies from the AXP. The Treasurer shall keep accurate account of all receipts and disbursements of AXP funds and present a

copy of an up-to-date report to the AXP Board at each meeting.

2: The Treasurer shall disburse funds only upon receipt of a voucher. The voucher must be signed by the Financial Secretary and the President. When the President is the recipient of funds distributed by voucher, the voucher must be signed by the Financial Secretary and/or either the First Vice President or Second Vice President.

3: In an emergency situation, the President may authorize an expenditure of up to \$200; anything over \$200 must have AXP Board approval. Every expenditure must be followed with a voucher signed by the President and the Financial Secretary.

4: All monies belonging to the AXP shall be placed in a depository in the State of Ohio, in the name of the AXP, unless specific exception is approved by the AXP Board. All expenditures must be signed by the Treasurer for a withdrawal from the Museum and Loyalty accounts.

5: The books of the Treasurer shall be audited yearly on the first day of the Reunion.

6: The Treasurer shall be bonded by a reliable bonding company. The Treasurer shall obtain a bond, or bonds, covering all members of the AXP Board responsible for receiving or disbursing AXP monies. Bonding to be furnished from August 1st-July 31st, in a reasonable amount paid for by the AXP.

7: The Treasurer shall have the AXP account checkbook in his/her possession at each meeting of the AXP or AXP Board.

RECORDING SECRETARY –

1: The Recording Secretary shall prepare minutes of all AXP Board and general membership meetings. He/she shall perform the duties assigned by the AXP and/or President.

2: The Recording Secretary shall maintain all AXP minutes and keep a copy of such minutes in the AXP Museum (or other designated location). He/she shall have in his/ her possession at each meeting a copy of the minutes of the last AXP meeting and a copy of the Constitution and By-Laws.

CHAPLAIN –

1: The Chaplain shall officiate at the Opening of AXP meetings and shall arrange a suitable Memorial at the time of Reunion for all deceased members of the AXP.

2: The Chaplain shall officially represent the AXP at Memorial Day service. Working with 1st Vice President.

3. Keep updated records of Deaths

4. Conduct Memorial Service Saturday of Reunion and Chapel Service Sunday Morning of Reunion

REUNION RULES

1.) 2017 Reunion will open at 9:00am on Friday & close at 3:00pm on Sunday.

2.) All Ex-Pupils, Ex-Pupil's Families, Past Employees, Past Employee's Families & Friends are Welcome to attend Reunion & All Special Events.

3.) **Dues-Paid Members** will be issue badges at Reunion Check in. See Membership for pricing. **Non-Paid Members** will be offered a Meal Wristband at the cost of \$10 per day Banquet meal tickets can be purchased for an additional cost of \$20

4.) **Badges** are to be worn to be admitted into: BINGO, Meetings, & Voting at Reunion

5.) **All** Ex-Pupils & Guests attending Reunion or Any Special Event on the Home Grounds shall observe the following:

A.) You may drive around the campus, but park in only approved parking spaces.

B.) Please stay out of buildings except the

ones opened to the AXP. **Note:** Please observe times provided by AXP.

C.) Fireworks are **NOT** permitted on Home Grounds

D.) Alcohol in **NOT** permitted on Home Grounds

E.) Smoking is **NOT** permitted on Home Grounds

F.) There is **Absolutely NO Solicitation** at Reunion. **Note:** Unless first approved by the AXP Board prior to Reunion & Special Events.

Ex-Pupils are responsible for their own children; Please do not leave them unattended or without proper supervision.
