PAYMENT INFORMATION

Restitution payments must be made to the ***DeKalb County Prosecuting Attorney's Office*** in one of the following ways: cashier's check, money order, Visa, MasterCard, Discover, American Express, or a firm check from the defendant's attorney of record. **We can NOT accept cash or personal checks.**

If the defendant has a payment plan, it is the defendant's responsibility to keep track of the remaining balances. Final payments need to be made in the **exact** amount due. If there is a question regarding the balance, please contact our office

Payments by debit or credit card have a minimum additional charge of \$2.00 and payments greater than \$50.00 will be charged 4%. Payments by phone have an additional charge of \$3.50.

To pay by cashier's check, money order, or firm check: Payments will be required to be made in the exact amount due and made payable to the appropriate victim(s). Administrative handling fees will be a separate payment made payable to the "DeKalb County Prosecuting Attorney's Office." These may be mailed in or brought in to our office.

To pay by phone with a debit/credit card: Prior to calling in, please gather the following payment information: credit/debit card, defendant name, case number, and the total payment amount. (877) 222-4668

**If money is owed to multiple victims, please total those amounts and enter the total payment amount. Entering each victim amount separately will result in multiple processing charges.

To pay online with a debit/credit card: Go to www.missouripayments.com. Select "*DeKalb Cnty MO Prosecuting Atty*" on the drop down menu. Gather the following payment information: credit/debit card, defendant name, case number, and the total payment amount.

**If money is owed to multiple victims, please total those amounts and enter the total payment amount. Entering each victim amount separately will result in multiple processing charges.

To pay with a debit/credit card: Debit/Credit card payments can also be made in our office during business hours. Please note that the fees do still apply.

Notice regarding Bad Checks: If criminal charges have been filed with the court, then you are paying restitution. If criminal charges have not been filed with the court, but you have received a notice of bad check from our office then you are paying bad check restitution.
