**Block 6**

Fabric required: **note to self** (label the size square after cutting)

My fabrics:

**Group 1:**

background (yellow)

(4) 2 1/2" squares

(4) 3" squares

light (pink)

(4) 2 1/2" squares

medium (red)

(4) 3" squares

**Group 2:**

background

(1) 5 1/4" square

(4) 2 7/8" square

dark (blue)

(1) 5 1/4" square

(4) 2 7/8" square

**Group 3**


medium (red)

(1) 4 1/2" square

**Directions:**

**Group 1**

Half square triangles (HST) and squares

Gather the 3" background squares and 3" light squares (wasn't it easy to gather with the squares marked)?

Pair up the background with a light square (remember, right sides together) and draw 1 diagonal line on the (4) light squares. Sew a scant 1/4" away on both sides of the drawn line.


Cut on the drawn line and press towards the light side. Trim all to 2 1/2" square. You will have (8).

You will make (4) group 1 sections. Layout the HST and the rest of the squares from group 1 (4) 2 1/2" background and (4) 2 1/2" square of the light to match picture of group 1. Make (4) of them.


### Group 2

Flying Geese

Gather the large background square (5 1/4") and the small dark squares (2 7/8"). Lay background right side up and place (2) small squares with right sides facing down on top as show.



Draw one diagonal line and stitch a scant 1/4" away on both sides of the drawn line. Cut on the drawn line and press to the smaller triangles.



Place another small square as shown, draw diagonal line and stitch 1/4" on both sides of the drawn line. Repeat with remaining unit.

Trim to 4 1/2" x 2 1/2" for each geese.

Repeat the flying geese directions using the large dark square (5 1/4") and the small background squares (2 7/8").

Looking at the group 2 picture, sew the flying geese together to make 4 pairs.

### Group 3

It is the medium (red) 4 1/2" square.

### Putting it all together

Layout the groups as shown as sew together. It should measure 12 1/2" x 12 1/2"
