All cattle and bison 18 month or older require official ID tag.

Bison must have ID tag upon arrival, we cannot tag. We can tag all cattle at market for \$3.00 each.

SALE ORDER (each group in order consigned)...

Friday 10:00 a.m. Miscellaneous, Barnyard Fowl, Pea Fowl, Pheasants, Quail, Game Birds, Swans (mute must be pinioned), Warm Room

Saturday 8:30 a.m. Cages & Equipment on the outside.

9:00 a.m. Filler & Misc., inside Horse Arena (items must be related to alt. animals & birds)

10:00 a.m. Sheep, Goats, Llama & Alpaca, Ratites, Camel, Buffalo, Cattle, Zebra, Zedonks, Deer, Elk, Antelope, Pigs, Ponies, Donkeys.

*****Bottle Babies will sell with their species (each must have their own cage).**

(Animals that have a halter on when sold must have a halter left on them.)

CONSIGNORS: Please attach a sign on pen or cage describing consignment, number of head, sex, age, color, etc. We reserve the right to refuse consignments of caged animals if USDA requirements are not met and cages sell with animal. All cages must have a food and a water dish and have food and water in them. **No cardboard boxes.**

**All Species native to Indiana require a game breeders permit. *USDA permits required for all migratory waterfowl, buy & sell.*

ATTENTION CONSIGNORS & BUYERS: Checks for items sold will be available Tuesday, May 21st 8:00 am - 4:00 pm

Any checks not picked up will be mailed Wednesday pm. If you will be consigning out-of-state birds, they will require a pullorum test. Cages must have access to birds. Veterinarian available Saturday to Coggins test equine until 12:00 noon.

Commission - 10% Hoofed, \$25.00 minimum (Sheep, Goats & Ratites 10%, \$10.00 minimum)

All Other: 25% to \$40 20% Over \$40-\$70 15% Over \$70-\$200; 10% Over \$200.

\$3.00 minimum commission on all consignments. No sale fee is 1/2 reg commission.

NOTE: All sheep & goats must have official scrapie identification tag. \$3.00 per head if we tag.

Admission: \$5.00 per day, \$8.00 for both days. Reserved Seating Available \$10 per seat per day

Now accepting Credit Cards with a 3% fee.

Terms of Sale: Cash, Cashier's Check, or Pre-Approved Check w/Bank Letter of Credit, Credit/Debit Card with 3% fee.

All transactions are between the buyer and seller.
