Gary S. Gintner, 69, of Selma, Calif. and formerly of Elkton, passed away in his sleep Tuesday morning, July 6, 2009 at his home from a heart condition.

He was born Aug. 16, 1939, in Grindstone at the home of his parents, Matilda (Schneider) Gintner and the late Steve Gintner.

Gary was a 1958 graduate of Elkton High School and went on to Central Michigan University for one year. In 1961, Gary joined the U.S. Air Force and went to college in the evenings, receiving his associate degree in business administration from Warrensburg State College in Missouri while in the service. After his discharge from the armed forces in 1964, he moved to California and took a position in the corporation offices of the Carnation Milk Company in Los Angeles. In 1984, he began working with the Internal Revenue Service, retiring in 2004.
