

AMELIA VILLAGE, OHIO
Ordinance O-2018-15

**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING CERTAIN BENEFITS FOR EMPLOYEES
OF THE VILLAGE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the Council of Amelia Village (“Village Council”) provides certain benefits to its employees, including the option to purchase family health insurance coverage; and

WHEREAS, Village Council seeks to amend the benefits provided to its employees who elect to purchase family health insurance coverage from January 1, 2018 to December 31, 2018; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of Amelia Village, Clermont County, Ohio as follows:

SECTION I. All employees of Amelia Village who elect to purchase family health insurance coverage from the health insurance carrier designated by the Village shall be responsible for the payment of sixteen (16%) percent of the cost of such health insurance coverage for the period January 1, 2018 to December 31, 2018.

SECTION II. That the Amelia Village Council finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and, that all deliberations of the council and of its committees, if any, which resulted in the formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION III. This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and general welfare of Amelia Village and its inhabitants. The reason for the emergency is to ensure uninterrupted family health insurance coverage for Village employees who elect to purchase this option. Therefore, provided this emergency clause receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members of Council this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor, otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

MR. FITE moved to suspend the rules requiring two readings on two separate dates.


