Please submit a short biography at least a paragraph or two on your nominations. Make sure I have the correct spelling of their name, position, jurisdiction and local ICC chapter in which they are associated. I need all nominations by Monday, April 1. Thanks for your help and start nominating! Our awards to be submitted are as follows:

COAA Code Official of the Year – Preferably a code official for at least 5 years whom is working and doing an outstanding job at their position.

COAA Lifetime Achievement - Preferably a code official whom is in the last years of their career, close to retirement and has been an inspiration to others and has worked to make a better community with their contributions to the code and their jurisdiction. I think they should have at least 20 years as a code official for this award.

COAA Rising Star - This should be someone whom has at least 3 years as a code official and is seen as contributing to the advancement of code enforcement and their jurisdiction above and beyond the norm. They should be someone whom has the desire and will to help others and is seen as a future leader in their jurisdiction, the COAA or even the ICC.

COAA Chapter of the Year – One of our chapters whom has worked diligently towards helping and advancing their members code education, enforcement and understanding.
