- Sales/transfers are processed regularly as they come in from the county.
 - Exemption renewals continue to be submitted for agricultural, clergy, forest and non-profit. Due to Governor Cuomo's executive order the Senior Citizen (467) and Disability (459) will not need to be renewed this year. We have been mandated to carry over the 2020 exemption to the 2021 assessment roll. Unfortunately, I had mailed the annual renewal forms for both and had already begun to receive some back and processed them. These will be corrected and rolled back to the 2020 value. I phoned the balance of owners to let them know they did not need to complete the application I sent them. A couple I could not reach by phone and notified them by mail.
 - The resolution being considered by the town board will allow me to do certain aspects of my job for the 467 and 459 exemptions that are currently not allowed by the above-mentioned order. One of those exceptions has occurred and I will be able to tend to it once the resolution is passed.
 - Busy with phone calls and questions that arise each time tax bills go out.
 - Extremely appreciative of the new office location. This will be greatly beneficial to the public, particularly those that had challenges with the stairs. I am somewhat settled in enough to get me through the busy months from now until grievance day. Further organization and record storage/retention will happen after grievance.
 - A huge thank you to Barry for his hard work on the new flooring and new employee bathroom. He did an excellent job! He also went above and beyond getting my office moved and functioning again. I am still amazed how easily he completed it all, and always with a friendly smile and disposition. I believe Mark was involved in moving equipment and file cabinets as well, so a huge thank you to him too! And for his former office!

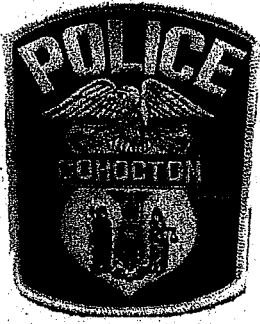

I hereby submit the End of Year Report for 2020 for the Town of Cohocton Police Department.

2. Over the past year we have seen numerous increase in changes in all aspects of governmental administration. As some of you know we as a municipality have to submit to Governor Cuomo a new revised police reform. I have attended numerous meetings on this reform with Corning Police as the first agency submitting their draft, and Steuben County Sheriff's Office presenting their draft to County legislature for approval. Within the next few weeks Cohocton PD will have the draft completed to present to Town Board for approval to submit to Governor's Office.

3. The community has seen a changeover in Personal with the retirement of the outgoing Judges, we wish them well and enjoy the Time off. Welcome aboard all new Judges, Clerks and whomever I might have forgotten. We can only hope 2021 will be a better year.

4. In closing the agency finished with 449 utt's written, 7 DWI (either alcohol/drugs), 7 drug arrests, 28 Aggravated unlicensed operations and 2 felony arrest. We handled 6 fraud complaints, 1 complaint we were able to recover approximately \$4000. From suspect to return to complainant, the other we were able to stop a package were a resident of Cohocton had mailed \$20,000. In cash to a suspect in New Jersey. This agency is small but very busy, there is more going on in the community than what a lot of residents realize, If you see something say something.

I followed up with Chelsea from Soil & Water regarding the salt shed, unfortunately we are no further ahead than when we started. There is still no funding available due to covid.

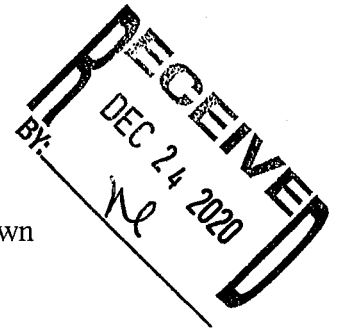
