RIVALRY WEEK

Alabama-Auburn, Ohio State-Michigan, Clemson-South Carolina, Arizona-Arizona State, Georgia-Georgia Tech, Minnesota-Wisconsin, North Carolina-North Carolina State, Washington-Washington State, Florida-Florida State and Oregon-Oregon State are rivalry games that will be played this week. These are games that may or may not have national implications but one this is for certain, they mean EVERYTHING to the fans, players and coaches. This is what makes college football so great. Whether you believe it or not, the outcome of the Florida-Florida State game is important because it's about pride and bragging rights. In most years these two are in the hunt for division and conference titles but I'll promise you, the players, the coaches and the fans want to salvage their 2017 season by beating their rival. The same is true for all of the games I listed above. Too many in the media ONLY focus on the teams at the top but all of the rivalry games mean so much more. Enjoy rivalry week!

FOOTBALL TIDBITS

Stanford's 17-14 win over California eliminated Washington from Pac-12 North contention, but next week's Apple Cup will still decide the division: - If Washington State wins, they win the North - If Washington wins, Stanford wins the North.

With their 52-24 win over FIU, Lane Kiffin and Florida Atlantic clinched a spot in the Conference USA title game against North Texas. The Owls are 8-3 this season after going a combined 9-27 in their previous 3 seasons.

In the win at Oklahoma State, Kansas State WR Byron Pringle became the 1st player in Big 12 history with 3 touchdown catches and a kickoff return TD in the same game.

Nick Chubb is the 5th player in SEC history to post three 1,000-yard rushing seasons. (Nick Chubb Georgia: 2014-2016-2017, Alex Collins Arkansas: 2013, 2014, 2015, Darren McFadden Arkansas: 2005, 2006, 2007, Kevin Faulk LSU: 1996, 1997, 1998, Herschel Walker Georgia: 1980, 1981, 1982).

In Ohio State's 52-14 win over Illinois, J.T. Barrett became the first Big Ten quarterback to throw for 100 touchdowns in his career.

Memphis secured a spot in the American Athletic Conference Championship Game with a 66-45 win over SMU. It's the 4th time in the past 3 seasons the Tigers have scored 66 points; they only reached that mark twice in program history before 2014.

Baker Mayfield has thrown a TD pass in 37 straight games, breaking a tie with Graham Harrell for the Big 12 record.

Yale beat Harvard 24-3 to win its first outright Ivy League title since 1980.

Alabama has won 73 straight games against unranked opponents, tied with Florida (1990-2000) for the longest such streak since the AP Poll debuted in 1936.

Florida State's 77 points scored vs Delaware State are tied for the most by any FBS team this season (Oregon vs Southern Utah) and 3 shy of the school record (80 vs Idaho in 2013). In that game, Florida State scored 56 points in the first half against Delaware State. The last FBS team with more points before halftime was Missouri on Sept. 24, 2016 also against Delaware State.

Jalen Hurts and Tua Tagovailoa have combined to pass for 6 touchdowns vs Mercer. It's just the second time Alabama has thrown for that many touchdowns in a game (the school record is 7 vs Southern Miss in 1950).

GAME-OF-THE-WEEK



ALABAMA AT AUBURN



The Iron Bowl has more at stake than just bragging rights this year as Alabama (11-0) travels across the state to take on Auburn (9-2). The winner of this game wins the SEC Western Division and will face Georgia in the SEC Championship Game. This game will be televised nationally on CBS at 3:30 PM EST.

Jalen Hurts has passed the ball very efficiently in 2017 but RB Damien Harris is the key offensive player for Alabama in this game. If he can rush for more than 100 yards, we think that Alabama will win this game. In 11 games, Alabama has given up just 112 points this season and has held 6 of their 11 opponents to single digits. If they can make Auburn one dimensional, the Tide will win this game.

QB Jarrett Stidham and RB Kerryon Johnson have really complimented each other all season long and it will be imperative that both have solid games for Auburn to have a chance but the key in this game will be the Auburn defense. If they play like they did vs Georgia, the Tigers will have an excellent chance to come away with the victory.

Alabama leads the all-time series 45-35-1. In games played at Jordan-Hare Stadium, Auburn leads 8-5-0. This is a very difficult contest to predict. We pretty much know what we'll get with Alabama, but Auburn is more difficult to predict. We're thinking that the Auburn team we saw vs Georgia will show up. We're picking Alabama to win 21-20.



CONFERENCE CALL: THE SOUTHEASTERN CONFERENCE

The SEC was established on December 8 and 9, 1932, when the thirteen members of the Southern Conference located west and south of the Appalachian Mountains left to form their own conference. Ten of the thirteen founding members have remained in the conference since its inception: Alabama, Auburn, Florida, Georgia, Kentucky, LSU, Ole Miss, Mississippi State, Tennessee, and Vanderbilt. The other charter members were: Sewanee, left the SEC on December 13, 1940. Georgia Tech left the SEC in 1964. Tulane left the SEC in 1966. In 1990, the SEC expanded from ten to twelve member universities with the addition of Arkansas and South Carolina. On September 25, 2011, the SEC Presidents and Chancellors, acting unanimously, announced that Texas A&M would join the SEC effective July 1, 2012. On November 6, 2011 the SEC commissioner announced that Missouri would also join the SEC on July 1, 2012. There has been some talk about switching Missouri to the Western Division and moving Auburn to the Eastern Division but that seems very unlikely in the near future.
