CLERGY COLUMN

Happy Lord's Day!

The first known Eucharistic Miracle is also the most famous. It took place during Mass in 750 AD in Lanciano, Italy. As I have mentioned in the past few articles, a true miracle takes place each and every time Mass is offered, even though it appears nothing changes. This can be difficult to believe with confident faith, sometimes even for priests. There was one such priest in Lanciano who doubted that Jesus is really present in the Eucharist. The miracle of Lanciano is ultimately the miracle of God showing this priest the truth of the matter.

While this priest was offering Mass one day, during the Consecration (i.e. the part when the priest says, "This is my body...This is the chalice of my blood."), the bread and wine changed in appearance into flesh and blood. He saw the Eucharistic Miracle and exclaimed to the people, "O fortunate witnesses, to whom the Blessed God, to confound my unbelief, has wished to reveal himself in this most Blessed Sacrament and to render Himself visible to our eyes. Come brethren, and marvel at our God so close to us. Behold the Flesh and Blood of our Most Beloved Christ." The people rushed to the altar to behold this incredible miracle.

After some time, the Eucharistic host remained as it appeared - a piece of human flesh - while the Precious Blood of Christ "dried" into five nuggets in the chalice. Local monks came to have a look and they found, using a scale, that each nugget of the dried blood weighed the same amount as the other four together. These elements still appear today as they did back in 750 AD.

In 1970, the archbishop of Lanciano called for a thorough scientific examination of the elements. The results are as follows:

- 1. The flesh is authentic flesh, consisting of muscular tissue of the heart.
- 2. The blood is truly blood.

3. The flesh and blood are human and have the blood type of AB positive, which is the same type of blood found on the Shroud of Turin (the shroud used to wrap the body of Jesus after he had been taken down from the cross), and is consistent with the blood of someone from the Middle East.

- 4. The proteins in the blood are consistent with fresh blood, as one who is still living.
- 5. There is no trace of salt or preservative substances used in antiquity for embalming.

What a miracle! There were further studies carried out in 1973, which confirmed the results listed above. The scientists performing these examinations could offer no scientific explanation for this miracle. Praise the Lord!


