

Shirley Rodriguez Remeneski Public Policy & Administration Scholarship 2017 Application

The 100 Hispanic Women National, Inc. (100HW) Shirley Rodriguez Remenski Public Policy & Administration Scholarship (SRR Scholarship) was created to enrich the college experience of community-minded Latina students who demonstrate leadership skills, academic excellence, and financial need. The SRR Scholarship provides eligible candidates an annual \$1,000 award for two (2) years enrolled in 2-year Associate Degree in Public Policy & Administration, Health Care Administration, or public service related field.

Student Eligibility Criteria:

- Latina student currently enrolled in a CUNY Community
 College as a full-time undergraduate freshman pursuing an
 Associate Degree in Public Policy & Administration, Health
 Care Administration, or public service related field;
- U.S. citizen or U.S. permanent resident;
- Cumulative high school GPA of 3.0 or higher -or- cumulative GED score of 3000 or higher -or- cumulative TASC score of 3000 or higher plus 2 or more points on Writing essay;
- Recent completed Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA);
- Cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher throughout CUNY Associate Degree program;
- Official transcripts submitted two (2) times each year (Fall and Spring semesters);
- Participate in annual SRR Scholarship Award Ceremony; two (2) annual workshops sponsored by 100HW and/or ten (10) hours of service to the organization.
- Commit to transfer to CUNY Senior College as full-time Bachelor Degree student directly upon completion of CUNY Associate Degree Program.

- Official high school transcript -or- GED transcript or TASC transcript for NYS High School Equivalency Diploma;
- Current official CUNY college transcript;
