From the Pastoral Associate: Our short second reading states, "The Spirit comes to the aid of our weakness; for we do not know how to pray as we ought, but the Spirit himself intercedes with inexpressible groanings." Probably must of us have had times where we know we need help, but do not know what we need. We have had situations when we honestly did not know what to do or even worse how we felt. All of us have probably had times when we have felt overwhelmed by life and its struggles. Sometimes all we can do is cry. In these times we need to cry out to the Lord in humble prayer. Usually this prayer will have few words, but many tears. If we don't know what to pray, or say, in our own words we need to pray something like, "Father, have mercy on me, in the name of Jesus, please send the Holy Spirit to speak for me and the yearnings of my heart and soul and give me what I truly need," or a simple "Father, help me!" or "Come, Holy Spirit, I need you." All these pleas of the heart are heard by our loving Father. Then we keep our pleading prayer going until we are worn out, or until our heart is at rest. Rest assured the Father hears the groanings of our advocate the Holy Spirit pleading in our spirit for our being. While in the midst of us reaching out for the Father, the Father in His love has already sent the Spirit with gifts of peace, joy, strength, courage, wisdom, rest or whatever good thing we most need for us to follow in Christ's footsteps.
