He was highly acclaimed as principal conductor of the Radio-Television Symphony of Vladivostok, Music Directory of the St. Petersburg Youth Symphony, and a professor at the institute of the Arts in St. Petersburg. He is also Music Director of the Renton Youth Symphony. In 2000 he was honored with the City of Redmond's Patron of the Arts award.
