Rules and Regulations:

- Open to all exhibitors 21 years of age and under as of January 1, 2020.
- Phelps County Fair, and its affiliates are not responsible for **ANY** accidents.
- Only use shavings and clean up everything upon check out.
- Only steers and heifers may be shown.
- All registration papers **must** be presented the day of show.
- Heifers will be shown by age and breed.
- Steers will be shown by breed and weight.
- There are no re-weighs after weigh-in. All weights final.
- All animals **must** be owned and shown by exhibitor.
- The judge's decision is final.
- A heifer may be shown in MCCA heifer shows if it falls between September of the previous years and November of the previous year. Ex: Current year 2020 (9/2018-11/2019)
- Show management reserves the right to interpret all rules and make any decision in the best interest of the event.
- In addition to the rules outlined by the PCSHC Show Committee, each exhibitor must abide by the rules outlined by the MCCA, which can be viewed at: www.missouriclubcalfassoc.com

Breed Categories:

- The MCCA requires that approved **market** animal shows use the following breed categories and format as outlined in this section (3.10.B) ANGUS, CHAROLAIS, CHIANINA, CROSSBREDS, GELBVIEH, HEREFORD (POLLED, HORNED and MINI COMBINED), LIMOUSIN, MAINETAINER, MAINE-ANJOU, RED ANGUS, SALERS, SHORTHORN, SHORTHORN PLUS, SIMMENTAL, AND MARKET HEIFER..
- The MCCA requires that approved **heifer** shows use the following breed categories and format as outlined in this section (3.10.C), ANGUS, CHAROLAIS, COMPOSITE CHAROLAIS, CHIANINA, CROSSBRED, GELBVIEH, GELBVIEH BALANCER, MINI HEREFORD, HEREFORD (POLLED, HORNED COMBINED), LIMOUSIN (combined), MAINETAINER, MAINE-ANJOU, RED ANGUS, % RED ANGUS, SALERS, SHORTHORN, SHORTHORN PLUS, SIMMENTAL AND FOUNDATION SIMMENTAL.
