



1. Charge your radio's battery. Take the antenna off and keep it - we'll use our equipment to test.



2. Download our **MAILING LABEL** and **PROGRAMMING CHART**. Click on the file type you want to download now - either [.pdf](#) or [.doc](#).



3. Package your radio **VERY** well. We recommend using USPS Priority Mail - **INSURED** for the value of your radio! (About \$9 - \$14 total.)
