
The Jo Daviess Water Resource Management Plan

In June of 2014, a group of Jo Daviess County citizens embarked on a two-year process of identifying and assessing issues related to the county's surface and groundwater. After careful study, they came to consensus on three broad goals designed to achieve incremental, sustainable improvement to water resource management within the county:

- *Enhance stormwater management*
- *Enhance groundwater management*
- *Protect/maintain/improve water quality*
