Auxiliary members, the 2016-2017 Membership year begins July 1st so it is again time to send in your continuous dues. We reached our 100% for the 2015-2016 year in March, and I would again like to thank you for helping us achieve that goal. I hope that between now and December 1st you all send your \$25 dues in so that your name will be entered into our December drawing. After December 31st you are not considered a member in good standing although you still have until June 30th to pay for this year and you have no chance for the life membership drawing. This year we will be drawing for TWO life memberships! If you decide to convert your continuous membership to a life membership and your name is drawn we will reimburse you the cost of your life.

At the National Convention in Charlotte NC it was voted on to increase the life membership fees 15%. This will take effect December 31st so if you have been considering becoming a life

member this would be the time to take advantage of the still low rates. The life membership fee is based on your age and I've included the schedule for you to look at. VOICE OF DEMOCRAY AND PATIOTS PEN

This is a brief look at two of the scholarship programs for youth sponsored by the VFW. Each program encourages writing skills in middle school and high school students. Competition is held first at the Post; that winner then competes against the winners of the other Post entries in our District; then the District winners compete to represent the Department of Colorado in the national competition.

Patriot's Pen is an essay-writing contest held each year across the United States for students in any school (public, private, home-schooled, etc.) in grades 6, 7, and 8. The program is designed to foster patriotism. Each contestant submits a 300-400 word, typed essay on the annual theme. This year's theme is "The America I Believe In." Deadline for submission of the entry form is November 1. The national first place winner receives a \$5,000 savings bond and an all-expense paid trip to Washington, D.C. Other national winners receive savings bonds from \$1,000 up. The entry form is online at <u>www.vfw.org</u>: click on "Community", then "Youth & Education"; then "Patriot's Pen"; scroll down to "How to Enter" and click on the link to the entry form and competition rules.

The Voice of Democracy scholarship program is an audio-essay contest for high school students in grades 9-12. Each contestant submits an original, typed essay between 3-5 minutes along with a CD recorded in the student's voice reading his/her essay. The national first place winner receives a \$30,000 scholarship that is paid directly to the winner's American university, college, or vocational/technical school. Deadline for submission of the entry form is November 1st. This year the theme is "My Responsibility to America." The entry form is online at

<u>www.vfw.org</u>: click on "Community"; then "Youth & Education; then on "VOD"; scroll down to "How to Enter" and click on the link to its entry form and rules.

Please encourage any student in grades 6-8 (Patriot's Pen) and grades 9-12 (Voice of Democracy) to submit an entry. Two years ago, our District 10 Winner went on to win National and received over \$30,000 in scholarship funds for college.
