



Riverview School of Cosmetology Application

To apply, complete these steps:

- 1. Complete Sections I, II & III.
- 2. Return **to your high school counselor** to review, approve and sign. *Attach most current academic transcript, attendance profile, and if available, SAT scores.* Applications should then be submitted to DCTC.
- 3. Cosmetology applications are due on or before <u>April 16th</u>. Applications received after the due date may be wait-listed. Student and parent meeting with cosmetology staff will be required for the selection process.

Course Description.

Cosmetology I

This program prepares the student for the field of cosmetology with Theory and Practical settings led by licensed cosmetology instructors. This program requires a commitment to maintain a 90% or higher in attendance and a GPA of 75% or higher with support from parent(s) and/or guardian(s). Preparing the students to become proficient in the basic understanding of cosmetology and cosmetology related business while working on soft skills such as customer service and sales. Attendance through the summer months may be necessary to achieve the goal of 750 hours, or half of the 1500 hours required to sit for the state board licensing exam. Transportation is not provided through the summer months. It is highly encouraged to plan any school time missed during scheduled breaks.

Cosmetology II

The second year program builds on the foundational concepts learned from year one, and add a more creative approach to the standard. Final preparations begin to get the students ready to take their state board licensing exam with classes specifically designed to create a mock state board experience. Preparing our students to become successful salon and beauty professionals by introducing them to local salons and other career avenue options. Attendance through the summer months may be necessary to achieve the goal of the additional 750 hours, or grand total of 1500 hours required to sit for the state board licensing exam. Transportation is not provided through the summer months. It is highly encouraged to plan any school time missed during scheduled breaks.
