

(News Excerpt) An early morning fire Friday destroyed the downtown Hutchinson studios of radio stations KSKU, KXKU, KNZS and KWHK and caused smoke damage to Sparks Music and the Wiley Building, which were on opposite sides of the radio stations at 106 N. Main. >>>>

Verne Ediger wrote:

In January 1971, my second cousin's wife, Elsie Esau Ediger, died in a fire at that location. At the time, it was considered a part of Wiley's, according to her obituary. It was a flash fire & there were 2 ladies on 2nd floor doing inventory on Sunday Morning at the time. *Several fire site photos are avail. See Hutch News Facebook site.


