1. Signs of the Times are Every Where:

Wars, Earthquakes, Floods, Tsunami, Hurricanes, Disasters, Rape, Murder, Robbery and Hate.

2. World Conditions are like a Dam about to Break.

Most are unprepared for what is about to Happen in this world. Rev.7:1-6. Mt.24:36-39.

Re 7:1 And after these things I saw four angels standing on the **four corners** of the earth, holding the four winds of the earth, that the wind should not blow on the earth, nor on the sea, nor on any tree.

2 And I saw another angel ascending from the east, having the seal of the living God: and he cried with a loud voice to the four angels, to whom it was given to hurt the earth and the sea,

3 Saying, Hurt not the earth, neither the sea, nor the trees, till we have sealed the servants of our God in their foreheads.

4 And I heard the number of them which were sealed: *and there were* sealed an hundred and forty *and* four thousand of all the tribes of the children of Israel.

3. . Though Problems frustrate us on every side - the solution is Jesus. Acts.4:12.

Ac 4:12 **Neither is there** salvation in any other: for there is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved.

4. . Review of How Jesus will come:

He comes with all of His angels. Mt. 25:31.

Mt 25:31¶ When the Son of man shall come in his glory, and all the holy **angels** with him, then shall he sit upon the throne of his glory:

He comes in all of His glory. Mt. 25:31.

He comes in the clouds and every eye shall see him. Rev. 1:7.

Re 1:7 Behold, he cometh with clouds; and **every eye** shall see him, and they *also* which pierced him: and all kindreds of the earth shall wail because of him. Even so, Amen.

He comes in majesty and might.

The world will wail because of Him. Rev.1:7.

6. The earth shall shake because of Him. Rev.6:14-17.

Re 6:14 And the heaven departed as a scroll when it is rolled together; and every mountain and island were moved out of their places.

15 And the kings of the earth, and the great men, and the rich men, and the chief captains, and the mighty men, and every bondman, and every free man, hid themselves in the dens and in the rocks of the mountains;

16 And said to the mountains and rocks, Fall on us, and hide us from the face of him that sitteth on the throne, and from the wrath of the Lamb:

17 For the great day of his wrath is come; and who shall be able to stand?

The question will be asked, "Who will be able to stand?" Rev. 6:17.

Why should Jesus Come:

5. He returns to Judge the World:

The cities of Sodom and Gomorrah are examples of divine vengeance. Jude 7.

Jude 1:7 Even as Sodom and Gomorrah, and the cities about them in like manner, giving themselves over to fornication, and going after strange flesh, are set forth for an example, suffering the vengeance of eternal fire.

6. Sodom and Gomorrah were destroyed because they gave themselves over to fornication and Homosexuality. --- Total depravity. Gen.19:5.

Ge 19:4¶ But before they lay down, the men of the city, *even* the men of Sodom, compassed the house round, both old and young, all the people from every quarter:

5 And they called unto Lot, and said unto him, Where *are* the men which came in to thee this night? bring them out unto us, that we may know them.

7. Sodom and Gomorrah are examples to those who live ungodly. 2 Pet.2:6.

2Pe 2:6 And turning the cities of Sodom and Gomorrah into ashes condemned *them* with an overthrow, making *them* an ensample unto those that after should live ungodly;

Note: Their Conduct was - Ungodly, Filthy, unlawful, wicked, Fleshly, Unclean.

8. Example to the Rebellious, Self-willed, disrespectful. 2 Peter 2:6.

2Pe 2:6 And turning the cities of Sodom and Gomorrah into ashes condemned *them* with an overthrow, making *them* an ensample unto those that after should live ungodly;

9. God visited Sodom & Gomorrah to validate reports of its corruption: God informs Abraham that He is going to destroy it .

Ge 18:20 And the LORD said, Because the cry of Sodom and Gomorrah is great, and because their sin is very grievous;

21 I will go down now, and see whether they have done altogether according to the cry of it, which is come unto me; and if not, I will know.

22 And the men turned their faces from thence, and went toward Sodom: but Abraham stood yet before the LORD.

23 ¶ And Abraham drew near, and said, Wilt thou also destroy the righteous with the wicked?

24 Peradventure there be fifty righteous within the city: wilt thou also destroy and not spare the place for the fifty righteous that *are* therein?

25 That be far from thee to do after this manner, to slay the righteous with the wicked: and that the righteous should be as the wicked, that be far from thee: Shall not the Judge of all the earth do right?

26 And the LORD said, If I find in Sodom fifty righteous within the city, then I will spare all the place for their sakes.

27 And Abraham answered and said, Behold now, I have taken upon me to speak unto the Lord, which *am but* dust and ashes:

28 Peradventure there shall lack five of the fifty righteous: wilt thou destroy all the city for *lack of five*? And he said, If I find there forty and five, I will not destroy *it*.

29 And he spake unto him yet again, and said, Peradventure there shall be forty found there. And he said, I will not do *it* for forty's sake.

30 And he said *unto him*, Oh let not the Lord be angry, and I will speak: Peradventure there shall thirty be found there. And he said, I will not do *it*, if I find thirty there.

31 And he said, Behold now, I have taken upon me to speak unto the Lord: Peradventure there shall be twenty found there. And he said, I will not destroy *it* for twenty's sake.

32 And he said, Oh let not the Lord be angry, and I will speak yet but this once: Peradventure ten shall be found there. And he said, I will not destroy *it* for ten's sake.

33 And the LORD went his way, as soon as he had left communing with Abraham: and Abraham returned unto his place.

Note: God agrees to spare the city if only 10 righteous people remain and angels are sent to remove Lot and his family.

Genesis 19:2.

12 ¶ And the men said unto Lot, Hast thou here any besides? son in law, and thy sons, and thy daughters, and whatsoever thou hast in the city, bring *them* out of this place:

13 For we will destroy this place, because the cry of them is waxen great before the face of the LORD; and the LORD hath sent us to destroy it.

14 And Lot went out, and spake unto his sons in law, which married his daughters, and said, Up, get you out of this place; for the LORD will destroy this city. But he seemed as one that mocked unto his sons in law.

15 ¶ And when the morning arose, then the angels hastened Lot, saying, Arise, take thy wife, and thy two daughters, which are here; lest thou be consumed in the iniquity of the city.

16 And while he lingered, the men laid hold upon his hand, and upon the hand of his wife, and upon the hand of his two daughters; the LORD being merciful unto him: and they brought him forth, and set him without the city.

17 And it came to pass, when they had brought them forth abroad, that he said, Escape for thy life; look not behind thee, neither stay thou in all the plain; escape to the mountain, lest thou be consumed.

10. The World is fast becoming as Sodom and Gomorrah:

1. Wickedness is increasing. Perversion is Prevalent.
2. The Sin of Sodom is the sin of Homosexuality. Ge.19:5,6. -1
3. Aids is Sweeping across continents killing thousands.
4. There is help for the homosexual. 1 Cor.6:9-11.

11. 1Co 6:9-11

9 ¶ Know ye not that the unrighteous shall not inherit the kingdom of God? Be not deceived: neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor effeminate, nor abusers of themselves with mankind,

10 Nor thieves, nor covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor extortioners, shall inherit the kingdom of God.

And **such were** some of you: but ye are washed, but ye are sanctified, but ye are justified in the name of the Lord Jesus, and by the Spirit of our God.

12. The Lord will come to Execute Judgment. Jude 14,15.

-Against those who have lived ungodly. Jude 15.

- Against those who have spoken against Him. Jude 15.

Jude 1:14 And Enoch also, the seventh from Adam, prophesied of these, saying, Behold, the Lord cometh with ten thousands of his saints,

Jude 1:15¶ To **execute** judgment upon all, and to convince all that are ungodly among them of all their ungodly deeds which they have ungodly committed, and of all their hard *speeches* which ungodly sinners have spoken against him.

13. He comes to judge the Living and the Dead: 2 Tim.4:1.

2Ti 4:1¶ I charge *thee* therefore before God, and the Lord Jesus Christ, who shall judge the **quick and the dead** at his appearing and his kingdom;

1Pe 4:5 Who shall give account to him that is ready to judge the **quick and the dead**.

14. He separates the sheep from the goats --The true from the False. Matt.25:31.

Mt 25:32 And before him shall be gathered all nations: and he shall separate them one from another, as a shepherd divideth *his* **sheep from the goats**:

15. He comes to execute vengeance on those who refuse to believe. 2 Thess.1:7,8,6.

2Thess. 1:8 In flaming fire taking **vengeance on them that know not God**, and that obey not the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ:

16. He comes to vindicates the Righteous:

Ps. 50:3-5. 3 Our God shall come, and shall not keep silence: a fire shall devour before him, and it shall be very tempestuous round about him.

4 He shall call to the heavens from above, and to the earth, that he may judge his people. He will gather His faithful ones. Ps. 50:5

Those who have made a covenant with Him through Sacrifice. Ps.50:5.

Ps 50:5 Gather my saints together unto me; those that have made a **covenant** with me by sacrifice.

17. He will judge His people with truth.

Ps.96:13 Before the LORD: for he cometh, for he cometh to judge the earth: he shall judge the world with righteousness, and the people with his truth.

18. Jesus comes to redeem the Saved:

He comes to redeem us from the grave and take us to Heaven.

Ro.8:23 And not only *they*, but ourselves also, which have the firstfruits of the Spirit, even we ourselves groan within ourselves, waiting for the adoption, *to wit*, the redemption of our body.

19. He comes to redeem us from the oppression of this world.

Is.25:8 He will swallow up death in victory; and the Lord GOD will wipe away tears from off all faces; and the rebuke of his people shall he take away from off all the earth: for the LORD hath spoken *it*.

Isa 25:9¶ And it shall be said in that day, **Lo, this is** our God; we have waited for him, and he will save us: *this is* the LORD; we have waited for him, we will be glad and rejoice in his salvation.

Note: -His coming is literal not spiritual. Let us put our trust in Him.

20. Our sufferings cannot be compared with the glory to be revealed in us.

Ro.8:18 For I reckon that the sufferings of this present time *are* not worthy *to be compared* with the glory which shall be revealed in us.

21. He comes to redeem His sleeping Saints from the grave. And those who are alive and live for Him. 1 Thess.4:16.

1Th 4:16 For the **Lord himself** shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: and the dead in Christ shall rise first:

17 Then we which are alive *and* remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air: and so shall we ever be with the Lord.

18 Wherefore comfort one another with these words.

22. Jesus comes to Reward the Saints:

Matt.16: 27 For the Son of man shall come in the glory of his Father with his angels; and then he shall reward every man according to his works.

23. To Reward the Righteous *with* a crown of righteousness. 2 Tim.4:8.

2Ti 4:8 Henceforth there is laid up for me a **crown of righteousness**, which the Lord, the righteous judge, shall give me at that day: and not to me only, but unto all them also that love his appearing.

This Crown is a wreath of victory. The Triumph of Faith. "I have finish the course.. I have kept the faith." 2 Tim.4:8.

2Ti 4:7 I have fought a good fight, I have **finished my course**, I have kept the faith:

24. He comes to reward us with eternal life. John 5:29; John 3:16. Titus 3:7.

John 5:29 And shall come forth; they that have done good, unto the resurrection of life; and they that have done evil, unto the resurrection of damnation.

Titus 3:7 That being justified by his grace, we should be made heirs according to the hope of eternal life.

25. He comes to reward us with the inheritance of the Kingdom.

Mt.. 25:34 Then shall the King say unto them on his right hand, Come, ye blessed of my Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world:

Note: He comes so we may live and reign with Him.

26. Jesus comes to cleanse the earth by fire and to create a New Earth.

The Lord is not willing that any should perish. 2 Pet.3:9.

2Pe 3:9¶ The Lord is not slack concerning his promise, as some men count slackness; but is longsuffering to us-ward, not willing that **any should perish**, but that all should come to repentance.

27. Heaven and earth will Pass away.

2 Peter 3:10 But the day of the Lord will come as a thief in the night; in the which the heavens shall pass away with a great noise, and the elements shall melt with fervent heat, the earth also and the works that are therein shall be burned up.

11 ¶ *Seeing then that* all these things shall be dissolved, what manner *of persons* ought ye to be in *all* holy conversation and godliness,

12 Looking for and hasting unto the coming of the day of God, wherein the heavens being on fire shall be dissolved, and the elements shall melt with fervent heat?

28. The promise of a new heaven and new earth. Rev. 21: 1-4.

2 Peter 3:13 Nevertheless we, according to his promise, look for new heavens and a new earth, wherein dwelleth righteousness.

29. The Righteous shall rule in the New Heaven and earth. 2 Pet.3:13.

God will soon create a New World.

John saw the New Heaven and Earth. Rev.21:1-4.

Re 21:1¶ And I saw a **new heaven** and a new earth: for the first heaven and the first earth were passed away; and there was no more sea.

2 And I John saw the holy city, new Jerusalem, coming down from God out of heaven, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband.

3 And I heard a great voice out of heaven saying, Behold, the tabernacle of God *is* with men, and he will dwell with them, and they shall be his people, and God himself shall be with them, *and be* their God.

4 And God shall wipe away all tears from their eyes; and there shall be no more death, neither sorrow, nor crying, neither shall there be any more pain: for the former things are passed away.

30. Isaiah saw a New Heaven and New Earth. Is.66:22.

Is. 66:22 For as the new heavens and the new earth, which I will make, shall remain before me, saith the LORD, so shall your seed and your name remain.

23 And it shall come to pass, *that* from one new moon to another, and from one sabbath to another, shall all flesh come to worship before me, saith the LORD.

31. The Former Shall not be remembered nor come to mind. Is.65: 17.
