Jenks at Owasso

Trojans route Owasso 33-0!

Trojans started out great on defense Friday night against the Owasso Rams.

As the offense that sputtered early but when Jenks got their game in gear, it was over quickly for the Rams as the Trojans prevailed in a District 6A-4 33-0 route before 7000 at Owasso Stadium. It was Jenks' 11th straight win over the Rams (3-2 overall and 1-1 in conference play).

Trojan defense was in top form as they allowed the Rams only one trip into Trojan territory, and that was on the Ram's opening drive of the game. The Rams had trouble moving the ball against the mighty Trojan defense which forced four fumbles and an interception on the Rams. The Rams were held to only 89 total yards in the game.

Trojans handed coach Allan Trimble his 14th consecutive victory who is now 103-10 at Jenks. The Trojans have won 74 of the last 79 district games also.

Quarterback Andrew Brewer remarked after the game, "We weren't doing the little things right." Brewer finished with 199 yards and two TD passes and was 10-17 in passing with one interception.

Running back Freddie Carolina finished with 59 yards on 18 carries and scored 3 touchdowns enroute to the Trojan victory. Wide receiver, Jesse Meyer caught 4 passes for 97 yards with one of those being a 38-yard touchdown. After that, Jenks was off to the races and closed the first half with 20 points.

Trojans added 13 points in the second half and finished the game with 315 total yards, 210 of those
