*Gospel Mt 11:2-11

Gospel Reflection

John the Baptist asks a question in the Gospel this Sunday that doesn't make any sense in our brains. He has been preparing the way for the Lord for years, first in his personal preparation through study, fasting and penance and then by his proclaiming the coming of the Messiah and baptisms of repentance in the Jordan. He knew Jesus from before his birth. He leapt in his mother's womb when she heard Mary's voice. He was a cousin of Jesus and probably saw him at family gatherings when they were children. He correctly identified him and baptized him in the Jordan River. He was present as the Holy Spirit descended in the form of a dove and heard the Father speak from the cloud. Now as he is in prison, facing an uncertain future, he asks, and I para-phrase, Are you really, really, really the real deal?" Have I spent my life wisely? Did I do good? A simple yes to John's question wouldn't have been sufficient to answer his question, our question. It would have lacked depth and substance; it would not have soothed his heart. So Jesus answers in a manner that John, and we would understand. This exchange begs the question, "how do we see God?" Not in the spiritual form he takes in heaven; that is beyond our comprehension. How do we see his interaction with us? How do we relate to him as we go through our lives? This is the real question of Advent, and our answer becomes our gift to the Christ Child at his birth.

TERCER DOMINGO DE ADVIENTO
Reflexión del Evangelio

Juan el Bautista hace una pregunta en el Evangelio este domingo que no tiene ningún sentido en nuestros cerebros. Él ha estado preparando el camino para el Señor durante años, primero en su preparación personal a través del estudio, el ayuno y la penitencia y luego proclamando la venida del Mesías y los bautismos de arrepentimiento en el Jordán. Él conocía a Jesús desde antes de su nacimiento. Saltó en el vientre de su madre cuando ella escuchó la voz de María. Era primo de Jesús y probablemente lo vio en reuniones familiares cuando eran niños. Lo identificó correctamente y lo bautizó en el río Jordán. Él estaba presente cuando el Espíritu Santo descendió en forma de paloma y escuchó al Padre hablar desde la nube. Ahora, mientras está en prisión, enfrentando un futuro incierto, pregunta, y yo parafraseo: ¿Eres realmente, realmente el verdadero negocio?" ¿He pasado mi vida sabiamente? ¿Hice el bien? Un simple sí a la pregunta de Juan no habría sido suficiente para responder a su pregunta, nuestra pregunta. Habría carecido de profundidad y sustancia; No habría calmado su corazón. Así que Jesús responde de una manera que Juan, y nosotros entenderíamos. Este intercambio plantea la pregunta: "¿Cómo vemos a Dios?" No en la forma espiritual que toma en el cielo; Eso está más allá de nuestra comprensión. ¿Cómo vemos su interacción con nosotros? ¿Cómo nos relacionamos con él a medida que avanzamos en nuestras vidas? Esta es la verdadera pregunta del Adviento, y nuestra respuesta se convierte en nuestro regalo al Niño Jesús en su nacimiento.




