

Everyone prepared as best they could with packing up their homes, boarding up windows and sealing doors against the expected storm surge. This happening just one year after hurricane Hermine flooded Hernando Beach homes. Mother nature spared us the worse though dropping Irma to a cat 3 and sending it ashore in the Naples/Marco Island area. It then moved up the Gulf coast and then inland sparing Tampa Bay a direct hit. Hernando County officials and Withlacoochee River electric worked diligently to get our county's power back online. Hernando Beach came on the very next day. We are so lucky to have been spared the horrible devastation I in South Florida and

**MINUTES OF HBPOA MEETING,  
CG STATION  
SEPTEMBER 7, 2017**

The monthly meeting of the HBPOA was called to order at 7:05 PM by Gladys Moore, President, who led the members in the Pledge of Allegiance. Gladys then turned the meeting over to Kathy Frase, Vice President, who recognized and welcomed potential new members, some who are new residents and some who just had not been to one our meetings until tonight. She encouraged them to join the HBPOA and take advantage of all that is offered through our association.

Kathy then proceeded to introduce all the good people from Hernando County: Cecilia Patella (Director) and Rich Russell from the Emergency Management Department; County Commissioner, John Allocco, and County Administrator, Len Sossaman; Marine Corporal Steve Kelly; and Fire Chief Hechman along with several firemen from our HB Fire Department. She expressed our gratitude that they would take time from their really busy schedules to give us updates on prepara-

tion for Hurricane Irma, answer any questions from us, and show their solidarity with our community during this difficult time.

Cecilia Patella took the microphone first and shared the bad news that the latest report at 5 PM regarding the hurricane has it shifting more toward the center of the state which will impact us with possible tropical storm force winds and possible hurricane force winds. Rain probably won't be a big issue, certainly not as bad as it would be if we were on the other side of the storm. Storm surge is unpredictable at this point and more information will be forthcoming. She went into detail about the county preparation for shelters (special attention to people with special needs and even a shelter for pets) and many issues that have to be addressed so that we are all safe. It is likely that a secondary coastal evacuation will be announced sometime tomorrow. Their extent of preparation and organization, down to details, was most impressive. Each of our officials took a turn at the microphone to inform and reassure us. Len Sossaman assured us that they "have our backs," while John Allocco encouraged

people to be "pro-active" and to not wait until the last minute to evacuate if ordered to do so. Len also told us that plans for any needed cleanup are already being addressed. Chief Hechler assured us that the fire department would be fully staffed throughout this period and urged us to not become victims but leave if directed to do so. Corporal Steve Kelly shared that there will be deputies here at the beach to watch out for our homes while we are evacuated. Rich Russell added more details from the emergency management perspective. Questions were asked and answered throughout the give and take process. Any member present, in spite of the predictable fear and anticipation of this storm, had to feel that our county is doing everything possible to handle present and future safety needs of our community and the other communities of Hernando County. Their care and concern for us was evident by their having taken the time to come to our meeting. It is hoped that, at the time of the reading of these minutes, we will have come out at the other end safely with our homes intact.


Margo McConnell gave the treasurer's report as follows: balance on hand for the HBPOA General Account as of 8/31/17 was \$12,328.85 while the balance on hand for the HBPOA Entranceway Account was \$3,131.72 as of 8/31/17. The report was accepted as factual and will be filed for audit.





## **Cardboard Boat Race Rules Construction**

All boats must be built of corrugated cardboard and, if the judges deem it necessary, must pass the dreaded "Ice Pick Test" & Metal detector test!! This verifies that the boat is constructed of only cardboard. **No motors.** Your cardboard boat may be as thick as you want it to be. Thickness of cardboard doesn't matter at all. Remember, it must be all cardboard—**NOT** cardboard and wood or cardboard and metal or metal screws for holding. **The entire boat must be built of corrugated cardboard. The only exceptions are: oars and in the mechanical division the propulsion system, and steering devices.** These exceptions are of course, not part of the boat proper and can be constructed of materials other than cardboard. If you don't want your boat to sink, the Committee urges you to waterproof the entire boat with one-part substance paint. (A two-part substance would include those that require the addition of a catalyst or hardener.... This eliminates epoxy glue, fiberglass, and certain varnishes. One-part waterproofing substances are easily obtained at a paint or hardware store.) **EXCEPT FLEX SEALTYPE PRODUCTS.** You cannot wrap the entire boat with plastic or duct tape or any similar tape or wrap. Duck tape can only be used at the seams and stress points. However, you are allowed to reinforce all seams and stress points with tape before waterproofing.

**Contestants are not allowed to use any substance that might be harmful to the environment.**

**Contestants should take care to ensure that the construction of your boat does not include pointed projections and sharp edges that might cause personal injury.**

## **How to Be a Winner**

- Decide on design and sketch it. It can be any size. Let your imagination go wild!
- Do the bottom of the boat first. Two to three layers of cardboard glued together and weighed down - let set.
- Cut sidepieces. Cut against the grain of the corrugated cardboard to insure durability. Use dull side of knife when scoring to make a fold—makes it easier to bend pieces in proper shape.
- Glue sides to bottom. Let glue set.
- Carefully cover any seam with duct tape.
- Waterproof inside and out with any single substance compound, such as varnish.
- Paint and decorate the boat.
- **No Flex Seal Type Products allowed.**





## STONE CRAB SEASON OPENS OCT. 15 IN STATE, FEDERAL WATERS

Florida's recreational and commercial stone crab claw harvest season opens Oct. 15 in state and federal waters. To ensure this valuable resource is available for generations to come, take care when removing crab claws, and follow all protective management guidelines for stone crab harvest.

To be harvested, stone crab claws must be at least 2¾ inches in length when measured from the elbow to the tip of the lower immovable portion of the claw (see illustration).

- Maximum trap size is 24 inches by 24 inches by 24 inches or a volume of 8 cubic feet
- Traps can be made from either wood, wire or plastic
- The throat or entrance must be 5 ½ inches by 3 ½ inches
- **NEW:** Throat must be 5 1/2 by 3 1/8 inches in Collier, Monroe and Miami-Dade
- If the throat or entrance is round, it cannot exceed 5 inches in diameter
- **NEW:** Round throats prohibited in Collier, Monroe and Miami-Dade counties



- The trap must have a degradable panel that is 5 ½ inches by 3 ½ inches and is made of cypress or untreated pine slat no thicker than ¾ of an inch
- Harvester name and address must be permanently affixed and legible
- The buoy must be no smaller than 6 inches and must be marked with a legible "R" that is at least 2 inches tall.
- Buoys are not required if trap is fished from a dock.

### Trapping Regulations

- Traps must be pulled manually (not by a trap-puller). Any vessel that is rigged with a trap-puller will be considered a commercial vessel and the appropriate licenses will be required.
- Traps must be pulled only during daylight hours.
- Traps must not be placed in navigational channels of the Intracoastal waterways, or in navigational channels maintained and marked by any county, municipal, state or federal governmental agency.

### State Waters Harvest Seasons:

Open Oct. 15 - May 15

Traps may be placed in the water 10 days prior to the opening of the season, but once placed, you may not tend to the traps until the start of the season, at which time you may begin harvesting.

### Can both stone crab claws be harvested?



Yes. Both claws of a stone crab may be harvested lawfully if they are of legal size. Although it is currently lawful to harvest both of a stone crab's claws, this practice leaves the stone crab with few alternatives to defend itself from predators.

Although the crab can still obtain minimal amounts of food with no claws, having one claw (if the other one is harvested) will enable the crab to obtain greater amounts of food in a shorter amount of time. Stone crabs (like other crustaceans) have the ability to grow back their claws, but this process requires a large amount of energy in the form of food.

The quicker the crab can obtain the energy required to molt and grow its lost claw, the sooner this renewable delicacy will have another claw to replace the missing one.
