#### October is Apple Month Here is an Apple recipe for you to try and enjoy! Bon Appetite <u>APPLE CAKE</u>

Prep Time: 25 minutes

#### INGREDIENTS:

Cook Time: 1 hour

I teaspoon salt
<sup>1</sup> / <sub>2</sub> teas. Baking soda
1 teas. Vanilla extract
1 teas. Ground cinnamon
$4 \ \text{apples}-\text{peeled}, \ \text{cored} \ \text{and} \ \text{chopped}$

#### DIRECTIONS:

- 1. Preheat an oven to 350 degrees
- 2. Spray a 9x19-inch baking pan with cooking spray.
- 3. Combine flour, sugar, oil, eggs, salt, baking soda, vanilla extract, and cinnamon in a large bowl, mix well.
- 4. Stir in chopped apples until just combined
- 5. Pour batter into the prepared baking pan.
- 6. Bake in the preheated oven until a tooth pick inserted into the center comes out clean, about 1 hour.

Congregate Meal: a hot meal at the Center, Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday serving from 11:45 am until 12:30 pm. RSVP the day before, with a donation expected. Meals for anyone under 60 would be a \$5.00 charge.

Home Delivered Meals: A hot well balanced lunch is available daily to shut-ins living in Morrow County. Weekend and Holiday frozen meals are also available on request. Donations are expected. **Transportation:** Handicapped accessible transportation and escort service to work, doctor, appointments, beauty shop, grocery shopping social activities, etc. is available. Out of county medical appointments can be arranged with a 48 hour notice. Please call in advance to schedule your transportation needs. Donations are expected.

Information and referral: Trained staff to refer those that need assistance to the proper agencies. These services are funded by the Ohio District 5 Area Agency on Aging. Other services offered by them include: ADRN, Personal Care Homemaker, Caregiver Assistance, Adult Day Services, Energy Assistance, Minor Home Modification, Long-Term Care Planning, Housing Options, Safety Monitoring, Chore, Prescription Drug Assistance, Long-Term Care Ombudsman and HEMEN. for more information on these services, please call (800) 860-5799.
