

**2018 Shootout on the Prairie  
Boys Youth Basketball Tournament

- Format:** Pool play (3 teams each pool) with a minimum of three games guaranteed for each team. The top two teams in each pool advance to bracket play. A maximum of twelve teams will be entered in each age division. Brackets will be posted at [www.prairiebasketball.com](http://www.prairiebasketball.com) approximately one week prior to the tournament. All grades will play pool games on Saturday and bracket play on Sunday. Some local teams may be asked to play pool games on Friday evening.
- Awards:** Individual trophies will be awarded to the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> place teams in all age divisions. A maximum of ten (10) awards per team will be given.
- Team Fees:** Team Entry fee is \$130 if the check is received before December 31, 2017 and \$140 if received after January 1, 2018. The deadline for paid entry is February 4, 2018. Your team will not be confirmed until full payment is received.
- Admission:** Admission for Saturday and Sunday will be \$5, children under 5 - Free. There is free admission for players and two coaches. Admission is good for all day at all locations.
- Concessions:** Concession stands will be open during the tournament. A variety of food and drinks will be available. No coolers, beverages or food should be brought into the school buildings. Players may use water bottles. Thank you for your cooperation.

**Rules and Tournament Notes:**

- 1. Good sportsmanship is mandatory of all players, coaches and fans. Unsportsmanlike conduct will not be tolerated, and could result in forfeit of a game or games. Inappropriate behavior will result in dismissal.**
- Iowa High School Rules will apply. Games will consist of two eighteen (18) minute halves with a continuous clock. The clock will stop in the last one (1) minute of the first half and the last two (2) minutes of the second half, unless there is a 20 point or more lead. If tied after regulation there will be a two (2) minute overtime. If still tied after the first overtime, the second overtime will be one (1) minute. In case of a third overtime, sudden death will apply. Half time will be five (5) minutes and pre-game warm ups will be a minimum of five (5) minutes. Three (3) time outs per game. One (1) time out will be awarded for overtime play (no carryover). No full court press after a team reaches a 20-point lead. All technical fouls are two shots plus possession of the ball.
- Three point goals will count in ALL grade divisions
- Clock Monitor and Scorekeepers will be provided for the majority, if not all, of the games.** However, teams shall be prepared to have someone step in if needed. This volunteer should be 16 yrs or older.
- Players on each team shall be from the same elementary school, middle school and/or feed the same high school. If a team does not meet the above requirement the team shall play up one age division. The age division of the team shall be based on the oldest player on that team. Teams not adhering to these criteria are subject to disqualification. No refunds will be given to teams that are disqualified.
- All rosters are final at the start of your first game. Any team that is not ready to play five (5) minutes after their scheduled game time will forfeit the game. Five (5) players must be on the floor to start the game.
- All players must have light and dark jerseys/shirts with numbers. Home teams will be listed first on the schedule. Home team will wear white.
- College Community School District or the Prairie Boys Basketball Association will not be held responsible for injuries to participants or theft of personal property during the tournament. Coaches are responsible for their player's conduct on and off the court.
- All players, parents & coaches are to sign a Risk Acknowledgement and Consent to Participate waiver.
- Bring your own warm up balls. Game balls 28.5" in size will be provided.
